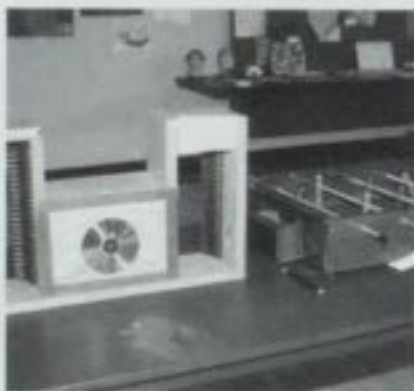

Who can hold our hands.

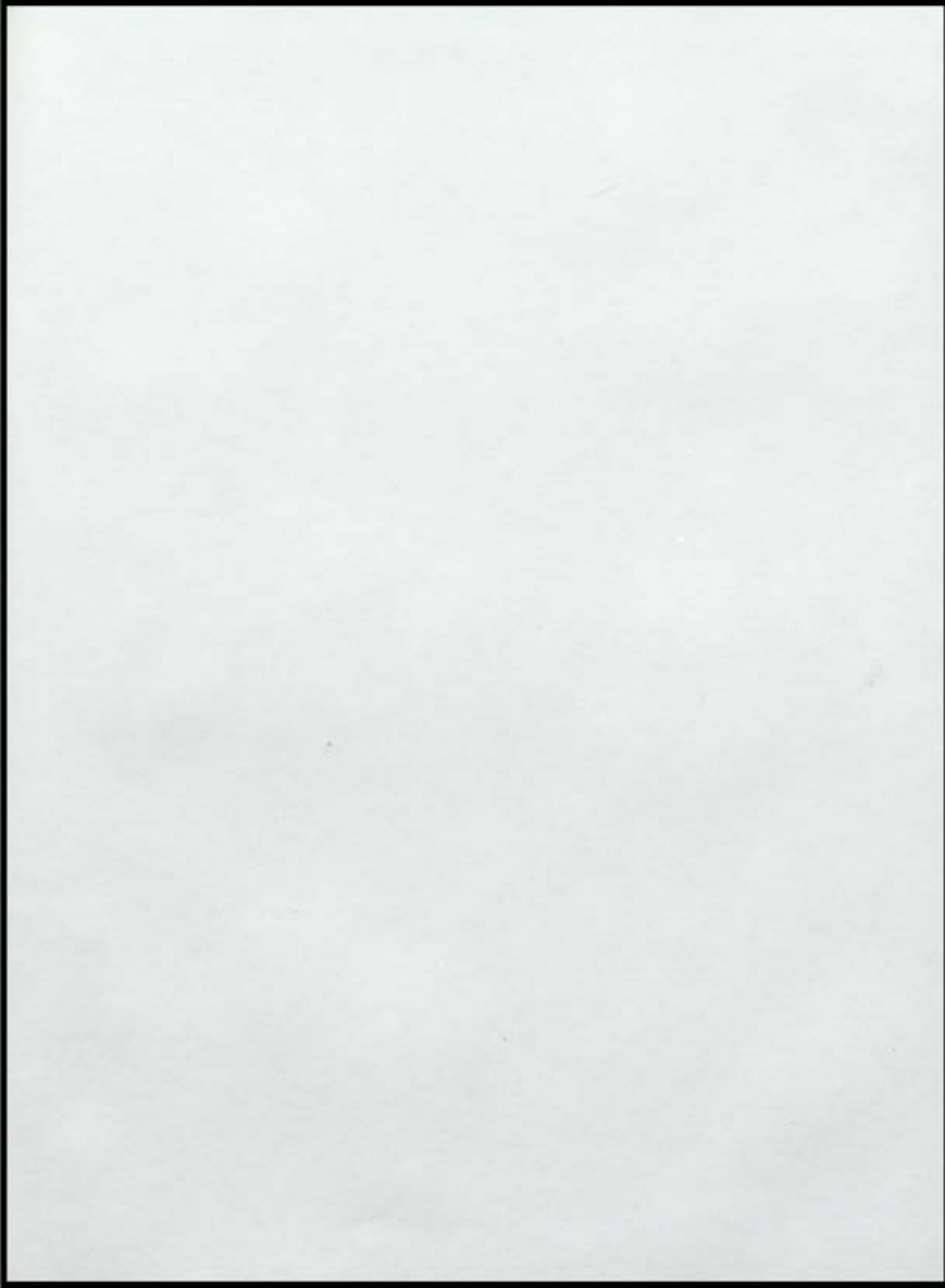

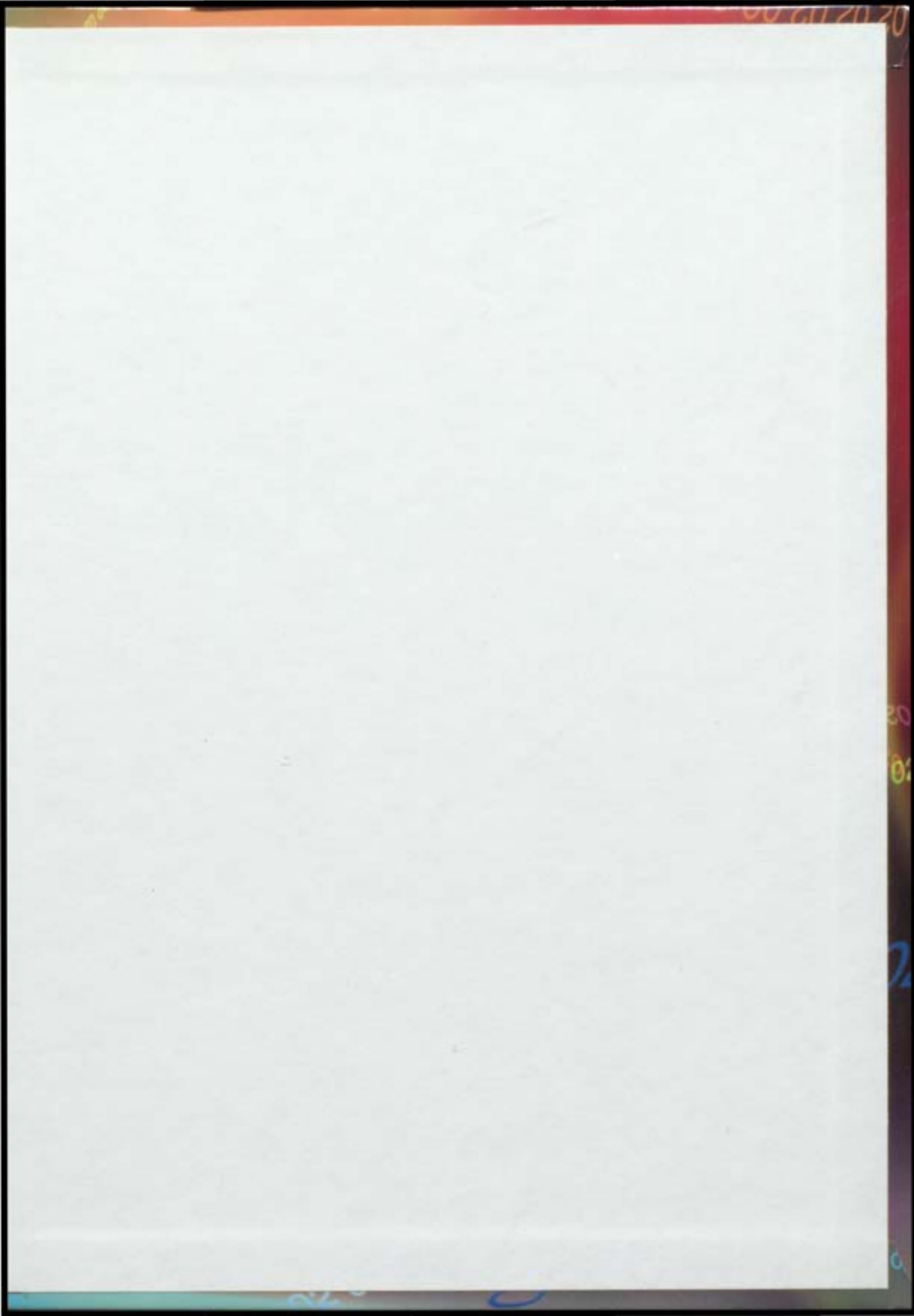
