His least favorite thing is missing his family (sister, dad and mom)

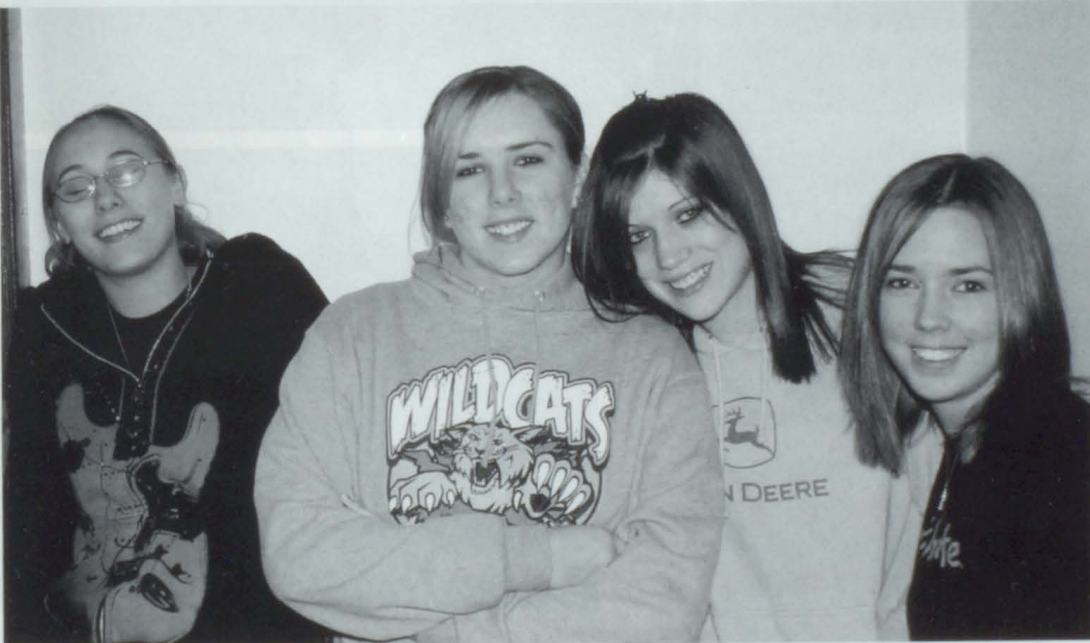
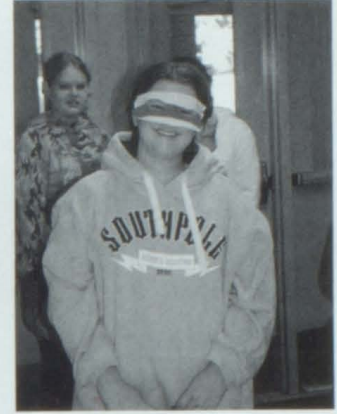
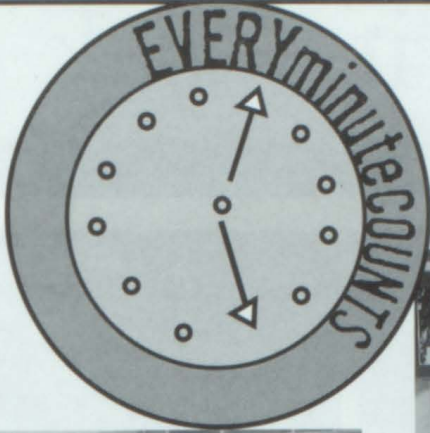

## What do you think?

Mrs. Taylor: "The interaction and engaged learning that goes on in my classroom using the Smart Board is what I have enjoyed the most. The biggest challenge is finding the time to create new activities and to get all the classes in the lab as often as they would like."

Ms. Benzek: "The biggest challenge has been learning where and what the available tools are capable of doing. The "capture" tool has been my favorite thus far. This tool enables the user to select images or text and immediately import the selection onto a notebook page. This has been a real timesaver in writing the problems from the text that students have questions over. I can simply "capture" the problem from the pdf file of the textbook and it is placed onto a notebook page ready to be discussed or solved."

Mrs. Zucco: "THEY ARE FUN! I like the big screen power points and films, and there are better, more interactive teaching and learning opportunities."

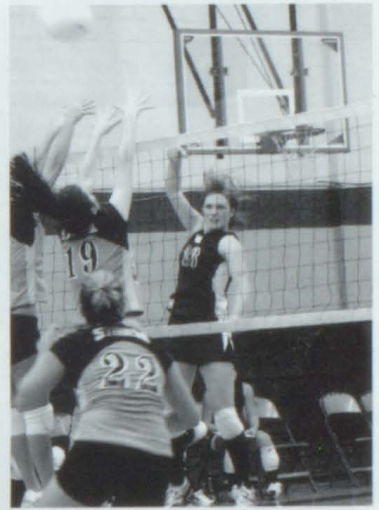
