

Bement Public Library District Board Meeting
May 17, 2022

Board Vice President Jerry Watzlawick called the meeting to order at 5:33 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Director Donna Techau and Board Trustees Erin Kindred, Connie Kinsella, Jill Lawson, and Ken Wright were present. Trustees Bill Gallagher and Mary Postlewait were absent.

Jill Lawson made a motion, seconded by Erin Kindred, to approve the consent agenda. All trustees present voted aye.

In old business, a lot of work currently is focused on planning for summer programming. The ROSC mass mailing was sent out, and it has yielded several sign-ups. Cabinets for the board room were ordered and should be installed at some point in the next 11 weeks. Parking lot work is starting Thursday May 19.

In new business, the library will be hosting a book signing by Mary Ann Weakley, a former resident of Bement. Employee Anna Quick has turned 18 and will be working more hours over the summer. At this time, her hourly wage is minimum wage, and she has worked at the library for almost a year.

Ken Wright made a motion, seconded by Erin Kindred, to increase Anna Quick's hourly wage by 50 cents per hour. Motion passed by a roll call vote.
