Driving the Prius Prime Limited from Los Angeles to the western park entrance at Panamint Springs introduced me to the fantastic highway capabilities of the vehicle. The plug-in hybrid is powered by a 1.8-liter. 4-cylinder E-CVT. The electronic-continuously variable transmission uses electric motors/generators to control the speed of planetary gear set components allowing the E-CVT to continuously change the gear

Blending style with versatility, the Mercedes-Benz GLC Class ranks as the German automaker's top selling SUV model, which consists of no less than eight different SUV versions including the GLA, GLB, GLC Coupe, GLE, GLE Coupe, GLS and the venerable G-Class SUV. The Coupe models are actually not coupes at all but are styled as such. The GLC lineup consists of several variations - the 300, 300 4MATIC, 350e 4MATIC, AMG GLC 43 and AMG GLC 65. We'll deal here with the 2020 Mercedes-Benz 300 4MATIC.

OVERVIEW

The GLC Class first appeared in 2016 advancing progressively through the 2020 model year. The 2020 Mercedes-Benz GLC 300 is a four-door, two-row five passenger SUV that has plenty of room behind the second row for personal gear or groceries. The fold flat second row is split 40/20/40 to provide a variety of cargo carrying possibilities.

The Honda CRV is considered by most to be the best small SUV's on the market today. The CRV has been a "best seller" for over a decade. The 190-hp 1.5 Liter Turbo generates more than enough power when loaded with gear. The CRV offers 36 cubic feet of cargo space with a suggested maximum load of 1,500 pounds and delivers an overall mpg rating of 28 miles.

I found the ride to be quiet and very comfortable. The CRV is available in 5 trim lines the EX, EX-L, HYBRID, LX and Touring. Two engine options include a 1.5-liter 4 Turbo and a 212-hp 2.0-liter 4 hybrid.

Android Auto and Apple CarPlay are available and CRV models range from \$20,050 to \$34,750. If your looking for a small SUV, I suggest you test drive the CRV at you local Honda dealer.





2020 Volkswagen Jetta GLi **Test Drive**

Volkswagen created the GLi in 1984 to take advantage of the popularity of the Golf GTi hatchback by offering the same performance enhancements in a sedan.

Now the sixth generation pushes the performance along, as its predecessors did, but add the benefits of modern safety capabilities as well as creature comforts.

For 2020 the Jetta GLi comes in two trim levels: S and Autobahn. It also gets the next-generation Car-Net telematics system and in-car Wi-Fi capability when you subscribe to a data plan. Autobahn models add standard wireless charging and an adaptive damping system for the sus-

The difference in the driving experience between the base Jetta and the GLi is well worth the premium to the price. The base Jetta feels flaccid, with little power and rather imprecise road feel, which limits the car's cornering comfort.

The GLi upgrades this mostly by equipping it with the same

Since 1948 the F-series pickup truck has been a constant in the Ford lineup; and what started as a post-war, work-only vehicle has over the last 70 years morphed into a do-everything-for-everybody phenomena - a vehicle that is now so important to Ford's bottom line that they wouldn't delay the new release - despite the pandemic restrictions. The virtual on-line release (hosted by actor Dennis Leary) was heavy on nostalgia, history and the iconic loyalty of F-150 buyers. But there was real meat in the marketing sandwich too. Have a look.

For 2021 the F-series is generationally updated – the first major update since the all-aluminum body intro in 2015, Here are the highlights on the new truck:

• A fully hybrid engine based on the 3.5LEcoBoost-now called the PowerBoost. Numbers have not been released but Ford is already claiming that they will have the most torque and horsepower of any half-ton along with at least 12,000 lb of towing capacity. Further they claim this engine will have a range

As youngsters, many of us have an experience with a vehicle that causes that particular object to become part of our subconscious, something that we can't forget and something that we become focused on attaining during our lifetime. Often this influence comes in the form of a movie car.

For Mike Roth, that movie was Vanishing Point - starring a 1970 Challenger. Says Roth "I saw the original Vanishing Point movie as a teenager in the late 70's and I knew that I must eventually have a Challenger!"

Roth searched locally in the pre-internet days, 1998 - he found the car listed in a local publication for sale and decided it was worth a look. The Dodge was rough but complete. Trashed interior, a history of local racing based on the long faded hand lettered drivers name ("Quick") on the door, and the normal rust that collectors find in these cars - the aftermarket sunroof being the primary culprit. None of that dissuaded Roth. This car was not being pressed into daily driver routine, it was

destined for greater things and despite the clear years of use and abuse the car was numbers matching. That said it was street driven and road tripped extensively for 5 years until it underwent a complete restoration.

For the non-Mopar readers out there - numbers matching is a big deal and especially with Chrysler family of products. Ma Mopar stamps her V8 engines on the pad at the lower passenger side of the block above the oil pan - 1969 and newer automatic transmissions are stamped on a raised pad on the passenger side front of the case. As of mid year 1969 and later engines only the last 8 digits of the V.I.N. were stamped on the engine and transmission. There are also several other places that have the vehicle's vin stamp: E bodies (Challenger and Barracuda/Cudas) will have it stamped on the driver's side cowl near the vent cover, 1969 and newer vehicles will have the V.I.N. stamped on the driver's side upper portion of the radiator core support and the door vin decal on the driver side door (opposite the tire inflation decal).

Today we see the results of all the toil and heartache that goes into the restoration of a dream car. This "Top Banana" yellow Dodge was equipped with a numbers matching 340 cubic inch engine, the original strobe stripes, stock suspension, Thermoquad carburetor, brakes and a fully restored stock interior. The car is 90% stock as it came from the factory all those years ago, Roth switched the car over to a manual TKO 5 speed during the restoration from the original 727 TorqueFlite, and added bluetooth to the stereo - all in the interest of making this Challenger a road tripping machine.

When asked about the process of restoring a classic car, Roth offers this advice: "Get as many recommendations for a shop as possible and go and see the shop's finished work. Even with solid recommendation your vehicle can fall into a limbo state as did my Challenger, for almost 4 years with minimal work and over \$2,000 in missing parts. Then an additional 2 years at another shop before the body work was completed. I was lucky, I did all the mechanical, I left the body work for the pros. It was just shy of 7 years from start to finish."

All this is water under the bridge all these enjoyable years later and with time the price of a restoration stings a little less as well, especially if you amortize the cost of the years of ownership - in this Dodge Challenger's case 22 years! It is worth it to save these fantastic vehicles, but get out there and put some miles under them and ignite that dream car desire in another generation.

fornia serving passenger cars to have four fueling positions and the largest capacity to date. The nextlargest station for passenger cars is the True Zero station in Oakland, with more than 800 kilograms. It opened in late 2019.

This station will be able to fuel three cars simultaneously, increasing the number of vehicles served in a shorter time. This and future stations like it will help meet the needs of the growing fuel cell passenger car market in the Orange County area and across California.

The station offers 100% renewable hydrogen. California requires that at least 33% of hydrogen fuel come from renewable sources. For stations that qualify for the Low Carbon Fuel Standard ZEV infrastructure credit, that amount increases to 40%

CALIFORNIA FUEL CELL PARTNERSHIP

Energy Storage & Hydrogen Infrastructure Funding Opportunities, in Addition to Hydrogen Infrastructure Progress Report

The California Energy Commission released two grant funding opportunities (GFOs) and one report that are important in the rollout of hydrogen fueling infrastructure and fuel cell electric passenger cars, and potentially key to the stimulus of renewable hydrogen production in California.

Energy Storage

The Energy Commission has noted that "while lithium-ion battery technology is a good short-term energy storage solution, the technology has safety concerns (thermal runaway) and long-term performance issues (limits on the number of cycles the technology can perform in a day or over its lifetime)."

GFO 19-306 will fund non-lithium ion technologies that can provide a minimum of 10 hours of energy storage. Hydrogen projects can potentially qualify for this funding opportunity.

Hydrogen is increasingly recognized for its ability to help balance the grid and provide long-term energy storage. Projects are already under way around the world, including one energy storage project in Utah that was announced last year.

Hydrogen Fueling Infrastructure

The Commission also released GFO 19-602, making available up to \$115.7 million in grant funds for hydrogen refueling infrastructure.

These funds come from Assembly Bill 8, signed into law in 2013. B 8 directs funding for at least 100 hydrogen stations for passenger cars, among other programs and activities.

More than 40 retail stations are open and more than 20 are in development across California. This grant funding opportunity, coupled with the new zero-emission infrastructure credit in the Low Carbon Fuel Standard, will likely fund enough stations to surpass the 100-station milestone and advance the market in support of the state's goal of five million zero-emission vehicles by 2030.

Former Governor Brown called for 200 hydrogen stations by 2025 and CaFCP has called for 1,000 stations by 2030 serving upwards of 1,000,000 fuel cell cars, buses and trucks.

AB 8 Report – annual report on station development

Assembly Bill 8 requires the California Energy Commission and California Resources Board annually jointly review and report on the progress of the hydrogen-fueling network. The latest report identifies the need for more hydrogen

stations to meet state goals. The current report and previous reports can be also found on CaFCP's Resources database at

of approximately 1,100 km on a single tank of gas.

• The look of the truck will still be instantly recognizable, but it has been massaged, particularly around the nose with new grille designs and a next-level look to the C-clamp headlights. The interior also benefits from new materials, colour choices and more storage.

• Tech upgrades include a new generation of SYNC (4) that expands the technology offered – including over-the-air updates.

• The tailgate has been the focus of "work-related" updates -basically creating a usable work surface - something most of us have used tailgates for - well,

• Pro Power Onboard is a generator that will push out enough power to run 28 average refrigerators says Ford. A by-product of the new hybrid engine setup this really is a leap forward in available jobsite (or recreational) electrical

So, for 2021 the F-series adds these innovations to the existing F-150 structure; including the fully boxed high-strength steel frame and the all-aluminum alloy body. With this new PowerBoost engine Ford is now offering six different powertrains in the F-series dressed up in nine trim levels. Ford continues to offer the greatest combination of power and trim packages in the pickup market.

There has been (and continues to be) lot's of talk about electric pickup trucks. These are definitely coming. But, in the meantime this new PowerBoost hybrid engine can be seen as a logical stepping stone towards that all-electric future. PowerBoost actually has more to do with the 10-speed SelectShift automatic transmiscontinued on page 8

The GLC 300 comes two ways with or without the 4MATIC 4WD system, which is a \$2,000 option. A power liftgate opens for access to the spacious cargo area, which also features storage beneath the floor.

Cargo capacity is from 19.4 cubic feet with seats up, to 56.5 cubic feet seats folded flat. Towing capacity is 3,500

AS TESTED

My test vehicle was a 2020 model Mercedes-Benz GLC 300 4MATIC SUV that had its base price set at \$44,500. The exterior was finished in designo Cardinal Red metallic, while the interior was executed in designo quilted Platinum White pearl and black Nappa leather with a black fabric headliner. Trim accents were done in natural grain Black Ash and brushed aluminum. The final price tag came to \$64,605 after factoring in the special paint, extensive optional equipment and value added packages along with the destination and delivery fee

PROPULSION

Powering the 2020 Mercedes-Benz GLC 300 4MATIC is a longitudinally front mounted 2.0-liter, inline turbocharged 4-cylinder engine that produces 255 horsepower in a range from 5,800-6,100 rpm along with 273 pound feet of torque at 1,800-4,000 rpm. Energy is geared through a 9G-TRONIC 9-speed automatic transmission with steering wheel mounted paddle shifters, to all four wheels via Mercedes' 4MATIC permanent AWD system.

STYLING

The GLC's exterior stands out In the world of cookie cutter designed market similarities, featuring a long wheelbase, short overhangs, a long hood and sleek profile. New front and rear styling includes all-LED lighting, sporty lower bodywork and chrome skid plate inserts. The clean, muscular lines and coupe-like side windows render it immediately recognizable as a modern Mercedes-Benz. There are new wheel options and low-profile roof rails; the redesigned GLC is an attractive SUV.

Moving inside, smooth flow and functionality are key, with the GLC's cabin setting a class standard for style and craftsmanship in a highly competitive marketplace. The center console is topped by a wide new display with intui-

tive controls, a cascade of rich wood, and a sensuousness that continues throughout. Color and trim options, and fresh new technologies create an up to date environment effectively covering all the bases. The GLC 300's spacious interior is more practical than a C-Class. The interior receives the latest MBUX infotainment system with redundant controls and a newly available 12.3-inch digital gauge cluster.

COMFORT, CONVENIENCE AND CONNECTIVITY

The 2020 GLC-class interior features attractive materials, excellent build quality, and comfortable passenger amenities. Luxurious standard equipment includes dual-zone climate control and power-adjustable front seats with heated cushions. The GLC 300 can also be upgraded with leather seating surfaces, a head-up display, heated rear seats, ventilated front seats, and

Mercedes equips every 2020 GLC with a versatile infotainment system that features a variety of contemporary control inputs. The standard 10.25-inch touchscreen supports the company's latest MBUX software that responds to voice commands. The system can also be operated by touch-sensitive controls on the steering wheel or an intuitive center console touchpad. While Apple CarPlay and Android Auto capability is standard, an upgraded audio system and wireless charging are optional.

The Mercedes GLC also offers the latest driver assistance key safety features including: standard forward-collision warning and automated emergency braking, available lane-departure warning, lane-keeping assist and adaptive cruise control.

PERFORMANCE

The non AMG-tuned Mercedes GLC 300 4MATIC may lack the maximum enjoyment and driving feel, but they do deliver a smooth and quiet ride with more horsepower than before and handling characteristics that approach a sporty level.

IN CONCLUSION

The Mercedes-Benz GLC 300 4MATIC is an attractive and desirable SUV that provides luxurious accommodations with pleasing performance and a competitive warranty coverage compared with premium rivals. Limited warranty covers four years or 50,000 miles / Powertrain warranty covers four years or 50,000 miles. Unfortunately there's no complimentary scheduled maintenance.

engine and brakes as the Golf GTi. That means under the hood is Volkswagen's 2.0-liter turbocharged and direct-injection fourcylinder engine, which sends 228 hp. and 258 lb.- ft. of peak torque.

That's 18 more horsepower and 51 lb.- ft. of torque more getting to the front wheels than the previous GLi model. Power gets to the road through either the base six-speed manual transmission or optional seven-speed dual-clutch transmission. The car has an EPA-rated fuel efficiency of 25 mpg in the city and 32 mpg on the highway.

Other performance upgrades include a limited-slip differential, Golf R brakes and progressive, variable-ratio steering. It also gets a MacPherson strut front suspension and multi-link independent rear suspension that's specifically for GLi models. Touching the ground are special 18-in. aluminum-alloy wheels fitted with 225/45 R18 all-season tires.


There are also appearance changes to ensure folks looking your way realize you are driving the model's performer. Naturally this starts with a more aggressive face. The front bumper gets a lower front spoiler and there is a larger air intake than the regular Jetta. The grille is filled with black honeycomb and a red accent stripe.


On the side there are lower side skirts to emphasize that the GLi suspension package lowers the car a bit more than half-aninch lower. In back there's a rear spoiler and a finned diffuser, again to point out the car's status.

You also get a number of nice standard features. Outside there are LED lights in front and back. These lights are quickly becoming standard and do a good job. Some of the driving assists are Volkswagen's Front Assist, a blind spot monitoring capability and rear traffic alert. Once you have used the standard keyless access you will discover the ambient lighting offers ten colors. There is also push-button start and stop as well as dualzone climate control.

You can opt for other features such as Volkswagen's Digital Cockpit, a panoramic sunroof, heated and ventilated front leather seats or even the BeatsAudio sound system. The sound system in the model I tested was quite good, especially for a compact sedan in the price category.

While I liked the look of the interior, it left me in no doubt that wasn't an expensive car. The interior's design lacked an elegance of, say, a similar-sized Audi. There was just a bit too much plastic, or at least too much plastic that looked and felt like plastic. continued on page 7

Book, saving buyers thousands of dollars over the course of their loan. Even though most dealerships are closed due to government guidelines, buying a car online, like buying almost anything now-a-days online, is a good option for those in the

Tips by Elkins were suggested to help facilitate the process: first, set a realistic budget considering your priorities: do you have a long commute/is fuel economy important to you? Do you carpool or need space for your client or clients? What are your musthave features? Remember that a car costs more than just a sticker price, there is insurance, gas, maintenance and repairs to keep in mind, too.

Second, begin researching online and price compare; keep a look out for deals.

There are cars that begin to make the best sense for you while pursuing your search, Elkins stated. Consider the incentives being offered by car manufacturer's, too. Ford and GM are offering deferred payments in addition to 0% financing, although, don't just buy a car you don't need because of great incentives. Stick with what you need in a car and then find the best incentives. Compare prices at different dealerships for that same model. Third, set up a test drive. There are virtual tours being offered by some dealerships as well as some offering to bring the car to you at no cost, in order for you to be able to test drive the car you are interested in. Last, negotiate the price. Kelley Blue Book and Edmund's True Market Value pricing were suggested as offering fair car values.

A sample conversation was provided by Brauer: "I know the market value on this car is \$28,700. I'm talking to a few dealers. I'm willing to pay \$27,000,"

Brauer also reminded potential online buyers to "Make sure you fully understand the financing terms". Some dealerships provide online signing and payment opportunities, while others may have you physically sign some paperwork, according to state laws. But the car can be delivered to your home and paperwork can be completed when the dealer drops off the car.

Elkins and Brauer concluded that "Even before the COVID-19 pandemic, there were increasing capabilities to do digital online car buying". But like so many crisis situations, the pandemic accelerated a trend that was already in movement. "We've gone from having a small number of dealers that were adapting and embracing this capability to a much wider range of dealers who know it's their only option right now, so they're happily jumping on board with this trend." Millennials as well as other demographics now believe having to leave your house to go to a physical location to buy something is just inconvenient or unnecessary.

Brauer concluded, "with going to a dealership not even being an option for most people, it's really bringing home the reality of the advantages of being able to do everything through a digital process."

The cars also wasn't particularly quiet, but most of that was caused by having the manual transmission and being driven by someone who doesn't try to emulate the shift patterns of an automatic. Speaking of which I found the shifting a bit vague. It was fine when driving hard, running the engine up in revs and shifting aggressively. But when driving sanely it seemed a bit sloppy. Not bad, actually, just ehh, if you know what I mean.

The motor is actually on the noisy side inside the cabin, but that was alright with me, since that motor is what defines this model. I was surprised how long it took me to get used to the power surge when the turbo came fully alive. Again, that's what makes the GLi worth having and something you adjust to quite quickly.

The car's suspension setup is better than you think it will be. Once pushed into a corner it hardens up nicely to keep everything copacetic. Perhaps the better way to say this is that the car doesn't ride like a hot hatch but can probably keep up through the twisties. Having said that, this isn't a car designed to upstage the GTi, or the other tuned-up compacts out there.

The better way to define it is that this is a family four-door compact sedan which is practical, attractive but not announcing to the world that you've become a grown-up. It shows that your busy life requires probity but allows for spirited enjoyment.

The GLi comes in two models, and prices start at \$25,995 and run through \$29,995 for the top model. While there is nothing wrong with the standard Jetta, I would want the GTi. While the base Jetta has a starting price of \$18,745, that's not the competition with which you should compare the GLi.

That price includes very little in the way of features, so it would seem to me the more realistic and meaningful comparison would be monthly costs and then whether the additional performance and features are worth having.

I would guess my vote is pretty

(while the company was moving fast to do just that) is emblematic of this administration's bumbling response to the pandemic, especially compared to markets in Asia that understood the risk, didn't politicize it and mobilized quickly based on experience of similar diseases.

Fortunately, the business community, and automotive sector in particular, has mobilized its procurement, manufacturing and logistics expertise to help healthcare workers, employees, dealers and customers, in an unprecedented response to Covid-19.

From producing masks and ventilators, offering great deals and free service, distributing coloring books from design departments and educating customers on how to disinfect vehicles, automakers

are giving the world a master class in flexible manufacturing and customer service.

Here are a few things Hyundai and Toyota are doing:

Hyundai Motor America

Hyundai Hope On Wheels donated §4.3 million to 22 hospitals throughout the U.S. to support COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing Centers and 65,000 COVID-19 RT-PCR tests developed by Seegene, a South Korea-based global leader in diagnostics. Testing centers supported by Hyundai have completed more than 200,000 tests.

Hyundai will make up to six months of payments for new owners who lose their jobs due to COVID-19 and have purchased or leased their vehicle between March 14 to May 17, 2020, through Hyundai Motor Finance. Through June 1 it's also offering 0% APR financing, deferring payments for 90 days at the customer's request, and extending warranties.

U.S. Hyundai owners with a 5year / 60,000-mile new-vehicle limited warranty or a 10-year 100,000-mile powertrain limited warranty that is expiring between March and June 2020 will have the warranty **coverage extended** to June 30, 2020.

Hyundai's First Responders **Program** now includes healthcare professionals and hospital employees (as defined by the U.S. Labor Bureau of Statistics), making them eligible to receive

\$500 offall-new Hyundai vehicles.

Hyundai dealers are also offering digital retailing and most will deliver new vehicles to customers' homes.

Toyota Motor America

According to Toyota, giving back is embedded in the company's DNA. Its US dealers are working to help the communities in which they serve, including:

Offering Wi-Fi at some dealerships so families can get internet access from parking lots for online learning to help students keep up with assignments.

Sand Mountain Toyota (Albertville, Alabama) has given out 8,216 hamburgers and hot dogs and 500 Chick-fil-A chicken sandwiches to students.

Beaver Toyota of St. Augustine (St. Augustine, Florida) is offering free interior vehicle disinfecting services to the local sheriff's department, as well as free oil changes to first responders, medical professionals and school personnel.

Kinsel Toyota (Beaumont, Texas) is offering free grocery delivery for anyone age 65 or up. Customers just place an order at a local grocery store, then call the dealership. Grocery orders are dropped at the customer's door, free of charge.

These inspiring examples are but a few ways that automakers are giving back and demonstrating they truly are deeply woven into the fabrics of their communities.

sion. It's 47-hp electric motor is integrated into the transmission where it adds torque as determined by the software that will also take towing into account. The power is stored in a 1.5-KW lithium-ion battery that is charged by the electric motor which captures energy while the truck is braking. The battery is packaged underneath the truck and does not intrude on normal interior spaces. This system does not take an outside charge – in fact, its function is to capture energy only while braking; this is energy normally wasted by a traditional gas powertrain. The standard engine is the 3.5L Eco-Boost that has been in service now since 2011. It already offers fuel economy with high horsepower so this addition of electric boost should go a long way to fulfilling Ford's claim of 600 miles - plus on a tank of gas. Of course, be aware, these claims are for an empty truck – putting a load on will tell another story.

The Pro Power Onboard system though is one of those innovations that we all knew was possible but no one was doing it. Granted a few 400-watt outlets have been available in various truck beds for a while – but that's not much juice. With a possible three versions, Pro Power will push out as much as 7.2-KW of power in 120

and 240V (or 20 and 30-AMPS respectively). These numbers are comparable to portable generators. This is significant; apart from working off the back of the truck, you could power your cabin with it.

The new look of the interior makes the F-series competitive with any of its competitors once again. As for electronics the center piece is a new 12-inch screen that is now the heart of all the infotainment systems. Ford also likes to add some trick items to each update. This time around we have fold-flat front seats. This is more than just a full recline – the seat folds back and the bottom lifts up to form a flat bed. Go ahead tell your wife you no longer need a hotel room – you'll just sleep in the truck. The other innovation is a bit more practical – the shifter folds flat and the center armrest flips forward to form a large, hard-surface work station. That I like.

So, these are the highlights of the new F-150 packaged together as the first salvo in Ford's marketing campaign. You can count on more hype and info as we move through summer prior to the truck's arrival in fall. More stats, numbers and pricing will be released later.

EUROPEAN UNION RELEASES HYDROGEN STRATEGY

Today, the European Union adopted strategies for energy system integration and hydrogen, paving the way "towards a more efficient and interconnected energy sector, driven by the twin goals of a cleaner planet and a stronger economy." In particular, the hydrogen strategy reflects the need and opportunity for countries and regions across the EU to collaborate on development and benefits from the expanding hydrogen economy. This coordinated approach will enable hydrogen integration activities to address needs and add value locally, while simultaneously creating a more resilient, durable and effective energy system—utilizing renewable hydrogen and electricity—across Europe

This strategy is one of many produced by California's climate allies. The Hydrogen Council estimated in its "Path to Competitiveness" report earlier this year that 18 countries had produced road maps or strategy documents, including the United States. And more are expected to follow.

California has not been idle either. In 2018, CaFCP produced a vision for 2030, The California Fuel Cell Revolution, calling for 1,000 hydrogen stations serving upwards of 1,000,000 cars, buses and trucks. Like other strategy documents by our climate allies, it recognizes the need for continued partnership between government, industry, investors and others to achieve a self-sustaining market. Most recently, the California Energy Commission released a Roadmap for the Deployment and Buildout of Renewable Hydrogen Production Plants in California, produced by UC Irvine's Advanced Power and Research Program, which concludes that, with appropriate policy support, the renewable hydrogen sector can reach self-sustainability (price point at parity with conventional fuel on a fuel-economy adjusted basis) by the mid- to late 2020s

The EU's hydrogen strategy, "A hydrogen strategy for a climateneutral Europe," looks at how to scale up and support hydrogen production through investments, regulation, market creation and research and innovation.

The document identifies three phases to this transition. We have retained their exact words below to describe the phases.

• From 2020 to 2024, we will support the installation of at least 6 gigawatts of renewable hydrogen electrolysers in the EU, and the production of up to one million tonnes of renewable hydrogen.

• From 2025 to 2030, hydrogen needs to become an intrinsic part of our integrated energy system, with at least 40 gigawatts of renewable hydrogen electrolysers and the production of up to ten million tonnes of renewable hydrogen in the EU.

• From 2030 to 2050, renewable hydrogen technologies should reach maturity and be deployed at large scale across all hard-to-decarbonise

The chrome grill looks huge when you look at it through your rear-view mirror. Most truck folks absolutely love it or absolutely hate it.

This truck has 20" chrome wheels, cab lights, huge trailer towing mirrors, LED fog lights, and a built-in step just ahead of the rear wheels to help load things in the bed. The hood has a large air scoop with the logos of AllisonTM transmission and DuramaxTM.

Under the hood you'll find the a 6.6-liter DuramaxTM diesel that is rated at 445-horses, and 910-pound feet of torque. New for 2020 is a 10-speed AllisonTM automatic transmission for improved fuel

economy, although the EPA does not rate ³/₄ ton and up trucks.

If you're looking for a gas version there is a 6.6-liter engine with over 400-horses and 464pound feet of torque. More than enough power to handle the 18,500 pounds capacity either gas or diesel.

This is the LTZ model with the Z71 off- road 4-wheel drive package. LTZ is next to the topof-the-line High Country, and there are 3 trim levels under it.

By 2016, Walter Gerber was looking to retire. Coincidentally Patrick Dobson, brother of Dominic Dobson was working at the shop as a mechanic. Dominic, a 7-Time Indy 500 and LeMans driver had previously raced for Walter under Bayside Racing; so naturally Walter couldn't think of any better successor than Dominic Dobson. The acquisition happened and Dobson Motorsport took ownership of Gerber Motorsport with Dominic now leading the shop.

EV Conversions, Virtual Reality, and Gerber Motorsport in the 21st Century:

Since acquiring Gerber Motorsport, the Dobson brothers have taken the company to new heights. The shop has been remodeled, a partnership with VR Motion has

been established, but most notably, Gerber Motorsport has been certified to perform EV conversions and added this into their service mix. A move that keeps Gerber at the cutting edge of technology within the automotive realm and brings them the accolade of being the first shop in Seattle that is able to do these conversions.

When asked why Gerber made this move, Dominic Dobson gave insight into the industry:

"When you start looking around, there's a lot of older cars that have engines that have problems, or engines you can't get anymore and people are saying listen, we can't keep burning fossil fuels. We're seeing a lot of the young (race car) drivers that are coming up through the ranks, and they're now of the mind set that electric cars would be cool."

Points in which I agree with. Having worked on a couple classic cars myself, it can be daunting tracking down parts, and building an engine only to have it get 12 mpg with mediocre performance numbers. Through EV conversion, much of this headache can be avoided while also yielding better performance than the original powertrain coupled with lower maintenance costs.

"People would be shocked at the performance gain" stated Dobson

With EV's there is no oil changes to be dealt with, services, or leaks. The benefits of an all-electric powertrain seemingly just go on. From fuel and maintenance savings, to instant torque, EV's just make sense.

Standard equipment includes

The 2020 Mazda CX-5 has a base price of \$24,350 and \$37,055 as tested. With 22 mpg city and 27 mpg highway, I would consider the 2020 Mazda CX-5 as a "valuebased" purchase and deserves a "test-drive" at your local Mazda dealer if you are considering a new SUV this summer.



ratio, keeping the engine at an optimal rpm.

The 2020 Toyota Prius Prime is the plug-in hybrid member of the Prius family and is now a more attractive and traditional looking hatchback. Prime distinguishes itself with 25 miles of electric driving only range and EPAestimated combined rating of 54 mpg. I exceeded the combined rating by two mpg. The mid-size sedan takes two hours to charge on a 240 volt connection and five hours on 120 volts.

As is normal in LA, I encountered plenty of stop and go traffic on the city highways and was pleased with the power the Prius exhibited along the way. The rain sensing intermittent windshield wipers came into play traveling the foothills out of LA. During occasional downpours the vehicle offered a quiet drive shielded from the weather and road noise was at a minimum.

Once in the park, winding roads climbed through the incredible mountain terrain as the sun began to set offering an impressive glimmering array of colors on the western slopes of the mountains. I was surprised by the elevation fluctuation making the way to the floor of Death Valley with an elevation of 10 feet before rising up to 4300 feet a few miles up the road. This was a continuously exciting drive complete with curves, dips, descents into canyons and then ascending back up the mountains. Prius Prime features a dual motor drive system that uses both motors to help propel the vehicle. This results in a boost in acceleration feel, improved efficiency, and the added benefit of EV mode at full

highway speeds. Handling on the curves was perfect and made an enjoyable ride and drive.

The quad LED headlights along with the accent lights and autodimming rear view mirror made nighttime driving easy. Another feature I really liked was the automatic high beam. A camera on the windshield aids nighttime driving by using the camera to detect headlights and taillights of preceding vehicles and switches automatically between low and high beams.

Death Valley is the largest national park in the contiguous United States with over 3.4 million acres. Badwater Basin at 282 feet below sea level is the lowest place in North America. Two to four thousand years ago the basin was the site of a 30-foot deep lake that evaporated and left a layer of salt. A briny pond four times saltier than the ocean - appears in the winter and during the heat of the summer, it becomes a puddle. Visitors can stroll on a boardwalk through the expanse of nearly pure white table salt in Badwater Basin. Close by is Artist's Drive featuring rocks in pink, green, purple, brown and black hues. A geologic tour of one of Death Valley's most explosive volcanic periods, the one-way drive is nine miles of dipping and curving road that weaves through colorful rock formations. Artist's Palette is about half-way along the drive where sea green, lemon yellow, periwinkle blue and salmon pink mineral deposits appear across the background like dabs of paint from an artist's palette.


A little further up the Badwater Road is the Harmony Borax Works where almost three tons

of borax was produced daily in the 19th century. The miners used 20-mule teams to haul the borax 165 miles to the railroad town of Mojave. The remains of historic buildings and a mule cart are on the original site.

Two other viewpoints that I recommend are Zabriskie Point and Dante's View. Zabriskie Point offers a panoramic view of golden-brown mudstone hills marked with hills and gullies formed from times when water rushes down these bone-dry slopes. This location is also perfect for viewing sunrises and sunsets. Dante's view gives an overview of the basin and range topography. At more than 5,000 feet above the valley floor, you can see across most of the 110mile-long Death Valley. Dante's View is the premier overlook in Death Valley because of the panoramic views that are waiting for you just steps from the parking lot. Below Dante's View is Badwater Basin the lowest point in North America and straight across the valley rises the highest point in the park, Telescope Peak at 11,049 feet.

From the low lands to the high mountain ranges and the interesting history and geology of the region, Death Valley is as awesome as the Toyota Prius Prime Limited is an energy efficient vehicle filled with

features that make it an impressive touring sedan.



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

dashboard design, and switches are all BMW; however this gives the car a luxurious feel on the

The engineering of the car though, is incredible. The Supra uses the infamous BMW B58 twin-turbo'd power plant putting out 335hp and 365 lb-ft of torque, combined with BMW front strut and rear multi link suspension. The Supra body is three inches wider and the doors are longer than the Toyota 86, making the Supra twice as stiff. This combination works perfectly inline to allow the Supra to lean into turns and explode out of them like a dog on fire.

Driving Experience:

With 335hp, the Supra doesn't look like anything outrageous on paper, I expected it to drive like my '07 335i coupe. However, the tuning of that motor, mated with the loathed 8-speed automatic is incredibly responsive and smooth. Touch the gas and you're able to go 0-60 in 3.8 seconds, stay on that gas and in the blink of an eye you'll be at 90 MPH+. The Supra never feels out of control though, the steel structure, low center of gravity, and 50/50 weight ratio gives the Supra a planted feel giving you a sense of security while traveling at high speeds.

All in all, as mentioned, I'm an "old soul" when it comes to car preferences; and have a tendency to prefer my cars with a key that you turn, a gearbox you shift, and few tech enhancements. The Supra however, has started to change my perspective. Do I think that this car would be enhanced by a manual option? Yes. But through the perfect harmony that is the driving experience you get while operating the new Supra, I've come to recognize and appreciate the different type of driving experience and joy that a vehicle packed with tech and delivered with the best of both German and Japanese engineering can bring.

Leaving Western Washington heading to the Columbia Valley in Central Washington is always a great drive to get a feel for the capabilities of a new vehicle because the interstates offer winding roadways that ascend through mountain passes along with straight-aways that give the driver the opportunity to get better acquainted with the comfort features that are available in the vehicle. The all new 2020 Hyundai Sonata Limited produced an impressive drive over the Cascade mountain range and through the incredible farming valleys to the Tri-Cities along the Columbia River.

With a longer wheelbase and lower stance than its predecessor, the exterior of Hyundai's mid-size sedan looks like a sports coupe from its seamless hood to its fastback rear design. LED headlights and taillights integrate with the chrome trim adding to the intriguing appearance of the sedan. During my drive of the Sonata, I visited one of my favorite wineries in Richland, Washington—Goose Ridge Estate Vineyard and Winery to pick up an order of wine at their convenient curbside window off their tasting room. When loading the wine into the trunk of the Sonata, I was amazed at the very adequate trunk capacity. The 16 cubic feet of cargo space is squared off to accommodate lots more wine than I purchased along with ample luggage for a road trip.

Goose Ridge's tasting room was closed at the time of my visit because of the COVID 19 pandemic, but I have frequented their tasting room and beautiful grounds previously and can give you a glimpse of what awaits visitors to this winery when the crisis subsides. The winery and vineyards are located west of Badger Mountain with beautiful views toward Red Mountain from the relaxed seating on the front patio. Another patio behind the tasting room offers shaded seating with a grassy area to picnic or play. Beautiful vineyards surround the facility.

Beginning as a family farming business in Washington's Yakima Valley early in the twentieth century, the Monson family later began establishing vineyards in the hills around Richland and in 1998 created Goose Ridge Estate Vineyards and Winery. Today Goose Ridge owns and operates the largest contiguous estate vineyard in Washington State with more than 2,000 acres of estate grapes for its five company brands and dozens of other wineries. The family-run business continues with the vision established by M. L. Monson and his son, Arvid. The company is led and managed by his three children: Valerie and Washington State University Cougars Bill and Molly with their spouses Darci and Rob who are also Cougars.

Varietals offered at Goose Ridge include Chardonnay featuring refreshing flavors of delicious fruits, Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Riesling, White Blends, Merlot, Syrah, Rose Cabernet and Red Blends. Outdoor essentials in cans under the Cascade Outfitters label are sparkling white and Rose. Goose Ridge's ciders are also a treat and are offered in several flavors including pomegranate, apple spiced pecan, pear and cherry.

Hyundai also offers a tremendous selection of options in their 2020 Sonata. Available in four trims - SE, SEL, SEL Plus, and Limited, the Sonata includes highlevel features that deserve your attention. A trio of powertrains —2.5-liter, turbocharged 1.6-liter and hybrid — are offered.

The Limited Sonata with a 180hp, 1.6-liter Turbo Gasoline Direct Injection four cylinder engine was the vehicle I tested. The smooth and quiet ride, spacious interior, and elegant fit and finis of the vehicle were impressive. Designed for comfort and convenience, the Sonata exceeded $my\,expectations.\,Gas\,mileage\,was$ 36 mpg on the highway.

Hyundai's SmartSense advanced safety technology includes: Blind Spot Collision- Avoidance Assist, Rear Cross-Traffic Collision-Avoidance Assist, Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist with Pedestrian Detection, Parking Collision-Avoidance Assist-Rear, Surround View Monitor and Front and Rear Parking Sensors, Remote Parking Assist and Blind View Monitor, Lane Following Assist, Rear Occupant Alert, High Beam Assist, Driver Attention Warning, and Cruise Control with Stop and Go.

Goose Ridge Winery also has a history of innovation and recently shifted to making hand and surface sanitizer as a way to partner with the community during these difficult times. The sanitizer is available for curbside pickup or online.

The Hyundai Sonata and Goose Ridge Estate Vineyard and Winery pair nicely to provide a great looking vehicle and beautiful wines.

a Wi-Fi Hotspot. The infotainment system features voice recognition, a rear seat reminder, and a BoseTM Premium stereo system. There is a wireless phone charger, USB ports, a 12-volt power source, and a very handy 110-volt electrical outlet.

Rear seat passengers have air conditioning vents, a couple of cup holders, USB ports, a power outlet, and heated rear seats.

The LTZ package comes well equipped, but this truck has almost \$20,000 in options, half of that being the DuramaxTM diesel.

This truck has the Premium package which gives you cooled front seats, forward collision alert, lane departure warning, power sliding rear window, park assist, blind spot monitoring, surround vision camera, a terrific heads-up display, and a power tailgate. You can lower the tailgate with the key fob, but you must push a button on the tailgate to raise it. Still, a power open and close aluminum tailgate is a very nice touch.

Chevy now offers new trailer towing mirrors that will extend out or fold in with the push of a button.

Inside the 6-foot 10" bed, there is a bedliner, bed lighting, a 120volt power outlet for tools, it is one of the camera views will allow you to see the bed and any cargo back there.

With a camera that offers 15 different views you can see the front view, overhead view, at the rear bumper for hooking up, and a transparent trailer view. An optional camera can be mounted on the back of your trailer to be able to see behind you.

A new independent front suspension and a new frame for 2020. It is a very quiet cab and the diesel engine is very quiet also.

The interior is very bland but move up to the High Country and it will cost you an additional \$12,400.

Total MSRP as equipped is \$73,265 and that puts it in line with Ford and Ram offerings. The standard base price is \$53,300.00.

This new Chevy Heavy-Duty has a capacity of 18,500 pounds. The DuramaxTM with the AllisonTM transmission work very well together. with your support; people who just do the right thing and not because they have too.

Here is one example from a story in the Los Angeles Times newspaper. Any monies which these patrons were out, Jim Trainor made sure they were reimbursed in full. Jim Trainor is Director of Communications for Hyundai North America and a friend of this publication and its editor. Thank you for personally caring and taking immediate action to help these owners.

Recently, California Governor, Gavin Newson came to the aid of an automobile manufacture, but in China where the Covid-19 pandemic was spawn. Where all of this is going, I have no idea. I fear we will be in this "kettle of fish" for some time with few answers or directions. Maybe we are part of some great experiment and don't need to know. Whatever it is, we are in it.

Stiffer Roadways Could Improve Truck Fuel Efficiency

Study finds simple changes in road resurfacing practices could improve gas mileage for heavy vehicles and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Every time you hear a deep rumble and feel your house shake when a big truck roars by, that's partly because the weight of heavy vehicles causes a slight deflection in the road surface under them. It's enough of a dip to make a difference to the trucks' overall fuel efficiency.

Now, a theoretical study by MIT researchers suggests that small changes in roadway paving practices could reduce that efficiency loss, potentially eliminating a half-percent of the total greenhouse gas emissions from the transportation sector, at little to no cost.

The findings are detailed in a paper in the journal Transportation Research Record, by MIT postdoc Hessam Azarijafari, research scientist Jeremy Gregory, and principal research scientist in the Materials Research Laboratory Randolph Kirchain. The study examined state-by-state data on climate conditions, road lengths, materials properties, and road usage, and modeled different scenarios for pavement resurfacing practices

They found that that one key to improving mileage efficiency is to make pavements that are stiffer, Kirchain explains. That reduces the amount of deflection, which reduces wear on the road but also reduces the slightly uphill motion the vehicle constantly has to make to rise out of its own depression in the road.

"When we as individuals walk on pavements, they seem like perfectly rigid things. They're not responding to us," he says. "But for trucks, that is not the case. There is enough of a deflection in that surface that some amount of energy is expended to overcome the little divot that you create as you drive along." He likens it to the difference between walking on a hard surface versus walking on sand, which takes more effort because you sink in with each step.

Looking to the future, Kirchain says that while projections show a slight decline in passenger car travel over coming decades, they show an increase in truck travel for freight delivery — the kind where pavement deflection could be a factor in overall efficiency.

There are several ways to make

roadways stiffer, the researchers say. One way is to add a very small amount of synthetic fibers or carbon nanotubes to the mix when laying asphalt. Just a tenth of a percent of the inexpensive material could dramatically improve its stiffness, they say. Another way of increasing rigidity is simply to adjust the grading of the different sizes of aggregate used in the mix, to allow for a denser overall mix with more rock and less binder.

"If there are high quality local materials available" to use in the asphalt or concrete mix, "we can use them to improve the stiffness, or we can just adjust the grading of the aggregates that we are using for these pavements," says Azarijafari. And adding different fibers is "very inexpensive compared to the total cost of the mixture, but it can change the stiffness properties of the mixture significantly.'

Yet another way is to switch from asphalt pavement surfaces to concrete, which has a higher initial cost but is more durable, leading to equal or lower total lifecycle costs. Many road surfaces in northern U.S. states already use concrete, but asphalt is more prevalent in the south.

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
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

Once you are comfortable enough with the ever-changing recommendations regarding road



for any pit-stops you might have to make.

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

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

33rd Annual Flagship Event Becomes Most Successful in Company History

Mecum Auctions held its most successful Indianapolis auction to date as the 33rd annual flagship event climbed to just more than \$74 million in overall sales. In all, the 2020 auction was host to 1,800 vehicles and more than 6,000 Road Art lots offered over nine auction days, July 10-18. The sprawling Indy lineup ultimately achieved an overall sell-through rate of 90% as the vehicles alone reached an exceptional 78% sold. Notably, 346 of the vehicles offered were sold to online-only bidders for a total of \$10.3 million.

Headlined by the offering of the John Atzbach Shelby collection, the 2020 Indy auction was not only a historic event for Mecum, but it also added to the history books for the Ford Mustang, as 5R002—the 1965 Shelby GT350R Prototype (Lot F140) from the Atzbach stables—became the world's most valuable Mustang ever sold. Demanding a final sale price of \$3.85 million, the car exists as the first Shelby R-Model competition car built and the first Shelby Mustang to win a race, easily qualifying it as the most historically significant Shelby Mustang in the world; its recordsetting sale in Indy marked yet another first place finish for The Ken Miles "Flying Mustang" as it eclipsed the world-record sale

price of the original McQueen "Bullitt" Mustang sold by Mecum iust six months ago.

Following on the coattails of 5R002, Atzbach's other Shelby vehicles made a strong showing in the top sellers list as well, claiming an additional four of the 10 top spots. At No. 3 was his 1966 Shelby GT350 Convertible (Lot F145) that brought \$1.1 million, and in seat No. 4, Atzbach's 1964 Shelby 289 Independent Competition Cobra (Lot F143) that sold for \$990,000.

Ferrari was another common moniker to appear among top sales in Indy, with the auction's No. 2 top seat occupied by a 1965 Ferrari 275 GTS (Lot S143) that sold for \$1.43 million, and seats No. 9 and 10 claimed by a 1971 Ferrari 365 GTB/4 Daytona (Lot S144) at \$715,000 and a 2011 Ferrari 599 GTO (Lot S117) at \$698,500.

We put forth tremendous effort to follow, meet and exceed all of the safety protocols necessary to provide a safe environment to conduct a successful, full-scale live auction. Not only did we succeed, we raised the bar," Mecum Director of Consignments Frank Mecum explained. "By enhancing both our on-site and live-online bidding processes, we were able to open so many new doors and allow everyone to participate in whichever way made the most sense for our customers. The results speak for themselves: the auction in Indy was the annual event's best outcome ever, and I think I can speak for everyone here at Mecum in saying that we are thrilled to be back with live auctions for our customers and fans alike."



Keith McCormick, Founder of McCormick's Palm Springs Collector Car Auctions Discusses How They Navigated Through The Covid-19 Crisis and Are Preparing For Their November 20th-22nd Auction

As one of the longest running medium sized Classic Car Auction housed in California I would like to share our experiences in dealing with the pandemic. We are now in our 34th year of conducting two Classic Car Auctions in Palm Springs California. Our last live Auction conducted was at the end of February and I believe possibly was the last live event before all others were cancelled due to the business lock down of live events. We knew things were starting to slow down as this event was miss-

ing our overseas regular buyers from Europe. The weather at this event was Palm Springs sunny perfect as usual in February, the crowds were large, but there was a feel of uncertainty. We normally run a healthy sale rate of 70%, but this dropped to 57%. The Arizona sales were all off in January quite a percentage, so we thought we were adjusting too. We feel now we were the luckiest company in the world to edge out a profitable sale before the Country and World shut down. On March 16th we closed our showroom offices for 8 weeks, but not before paying all our sellers out of course. We did not Qualify for the governments Payroll Protection Plan but chose to pay our staff full wages during the closure.

In California the Governor and our City officials classed our business as "Essential" and we are allowed to re-open using all CDC guidelines. On Monday May 11th we re-opened to start work on our November 20/21/22 2020 Auction event.

The Palm Springs Convention Center where we hold our Auctions has issued us our next two contracts to conduct these live events. We will be totally redesigning the tent layout to meet the safety health requirements of the CDC. The pent up desire from buyers and sellers to get back to the resemblance of normal is tremendous. The market will recover. The USA is well covered with some bright forward thinking leadership of Classic Car Auction companies that will take the bull by the horns and run with it as we will
