Steve Carlisle, Cadillac's President was quoted in the September 17th issue of Automotive News, the trade publication, "We have an arsenal of products and technology that will create even more differentiation for Cadillac and establish a very unique and attractive position for us in the global marketplace." These comments were made at the press introduction of the all-new 2019 Cadillac XT4, which I also attended. Carlisle went on to say "....we're going on the offensive."

Cadillac's plan includes introducing a new or redesigned vehicle every six months on average through 2021. In my 30+ years of publishing Auto News I have watched Cadillac focus on two main goals. Bring new models to market and attracting a younger group of buyers.

They have had limited success on both fronts but with the introduction of the all-new 2019 XT4 Compact Crossover it's a new ball game for Cadillac and it's dealers.

As Kia continues the quest for success, one of the best sellers in the Kia line celebrates its 3rd generation with lots of improvements. Everyone knows, crossover SUVs are the hottest segment in the industry. With all the good things attributed to the recently introduced Kia Stinger, updating the Kia Forte seemed like a natural.

This popular sport sedan picks up on the strengths of the Stinger while attracting the customer that is still drawn to this reliable sedan. The Forte is the best-selling vehicle in the Kia line-up. With the cowl pushed back five inches and the rear deck shortened, the all-new Forte is longer and wider than the previous model it replaces.

This non-turbocharged compact car retains its 2.0-liter 4-cylinder engine. It continues with 147 horsepower and 132 pound-feet of torque. A new 6-speed manual transmission is standard with a continuously variable transmission featured throughout the model lines. Known as the Intelligent Variable Transmission (IVT) the new chain belt driven transmission is configured with seven shift points to increase drivability that is more familiar to consumers.

Fuel mileage is 31 miles per gallon in the city, 41 on the highway with a combined 35 mph with the IVT. A three mile per gallon upgrade over the outgoing model shows how improvements including weight savings and transmission refinements fit in. During the initial drive, the Forte achieved an overall rating of 34

Honda Accord Test Drive Review

Honda designers pulled out all the stops with the makeover of the 2018 Accord. They gave it a new styling, a more spacious cabin, revised power trains and standard safety equipment.

The all-new body features a more assertive-looking nose with a large open grille, and a chrome bar that links the LED headlights. The windshield has been pushed back four inches, which not only improves visibility, but it balances the proportions of the car. The Accord looks even more impressive from the side view, with a sleek roofline that flows smoothly into the small rear-deck lid.

Inside, a large touchscreen dominates the center dash. Buttons on either side make it easier to access "home" and other settings. Push/pull levers on the console replace the conventional shifter. It looks cool, but it is not easier to use. Seats up front have improved bolstering, and most models have power adjusters for the driver. High-end models come with wood trim on the dash and doors—a welcome luxury touch.

Honda designers enlarged the cabin of the Accord this year by extending the distance between

Both Nissan with their Titan models and Toyota with the Tundra and Tacoma models are moving up the back stretch in the Great Truck Race for U. S. market share. The one thing I have learned in 30 years of publishing Auto News is never count Toyota out when it comes to crossing the finish line in the race to produce and sell quality vehicles including trucks.

The Toyota Tundra TRD 4 X 4 Limited Crew Cab is built "Toyota Tough," from the 5.7L i-Force V8 DOHC 32V 381 hp engine to the Double Wishbone Front suspension w/ Stabilizer bar,Trap Leaf Rear Suspension with Staggered Q/B Shocks, larger fuel tank (38 gallons) and a larger tow package with a new Tow Receiver Hitch and a 4.30 Axle.

If I was going to buy a mid-sized pickup truck, it would be because I didn't really need a truck.

The reason for that might be that I don't need a truck often enough to justify buying a truck to do it. Or it may be that when I carry things, they aren't heavy or big enough to need a full-sized truck. Or it very well might be that I like the idea of driving a pickup, whether I need one or not.

That being the case, the 2019 Honda Ridgeline should probably be high on the list of the trucks one should look at.

There is one exception to that. If you are looking for a mid-sized pickup with serious, and I mean serious, off-road capability then buy a Tacoma and be done with it. The same is true if you want a truck so your significant or spouse prefers to take a morecomfortable vehicle, the Ridgeline isn't for you.

That's because its really a Honda Pilot with a bed instead of a roof over the back. That makes it ride perhaps a little too comfortably. That makes the interior

Trucks, currently, have never been more important to a manufacturer's bottom line. Not only because they are selling in ever increasing numbers but because there just doesn't appear to be price ceiling. Customers keep loading up new pickups with luxuries that only a few years ago were found only in sedans. For 2019 that's why we not only have an all-new generation of Silverado (the fourth since 1999) but also, simply put, more of everything.

The new Silverado now offers eight trim levels, six different engine and transmission combinations – and for the first time – a new Duramax 3.0L turbo-diesel.

With the approval of the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, commercial vehicle tax deductions are more favorable than ever. If you're in the market for a new commercial vehicle and you work in an industry where you need to haul tools and materials through small alleyways and city streets while getting 22 mpg, look no further than the Mercedes-Benz Metris. What is The Metris?

For my review this issue, Mercedes-Benz of Lynnwood was kind enough to loan me a 2018 Metris Cargo van. After driving it for a few days, I can say I'm impressed!

Since its release in 2015, the Metris has been positioned as a mid-size commercial van. It's smaller than its Sprinter brother, but bigger than vehicles like the Nissan NV200 and Ford Transit Connect. Because of this, the Metris is able to boast an 186 cubic-foot cargo space, 5000 lb towing capacity, qualify for the 100% depreciation tax benefit with its 6,750 lb GVWR weight, and still astoundingly get 22 mpg.

2018 Buick Regal GS AWD Test Drive Review

Remember back when Buick was generally thought of as an entry level luxo-boat that appealed to more mature drivers? Be that as it may, that's no longer the case. The 2018 Buick Regal GS AWD is a prime example that adds: two more cylinders than before in the form of a 310 horsepower V-6 (a plus of 51 horses); a nine-speed automatic transmission; and a standard intelligent AWD system with an active twin clutch that can transfer torque between the rear wheels precisely, delivering a more refined, efficient performance and enhanced vehicle control by combating under steer as well as torque steer.

Also new is a second generation example of Continuous Damping Control that's capable of 500 adjustments per second, directed by Buick's Interactive Control allowing the driver to fine tune the vehicle's driving dynamics via three modes – a standard setting, a Sport setting, or a GS mode via a selection in the center console. There are performance brakes with Brembo front calipers.

This new 5-passenger, Buick Regal GS is a premium sport sedan that displays unique sport front and rear fascias, side skirting and a rear spoiler along with a sport-tuned exhaust system and GS badging front and rear. There's a sport-flat bottomed steering wheel and metal pedals. LED headlamps and a Head Up Display are avail-able options. The performance seating is GS-specific, AGR certified (Germany's Aktion Gesunder Rücken, or Campaign for Healthier Backs), heated, cooled, a massaging feature with adjustable seat and seatback bolsters, along with thigh support.

This Buick Regal GS (which is for Gran Sport by the way) is definitely not your uncle's or grandfather's stodgy Buick of yore, but rather an aggressive exterior expression of a four door hatchback styling. It's an attractive sedan that is sure to draw



NWAPA Announces 2018 Run to the Sun Awards

The Northwest Automotive Press Association named the 2018 Alfa Romeo Stelvio Quadrifoglio as the Northwest's Most Fun to Drive Vehicle in their annual Run to the Sun performance car and convertible event. The Stelvio Quadrifoglio impressed the participating journalists with its powerful engine, nimble handling, and Italian-inspired personality.

approach to construction is the reason for this. Strategic use of aluminum and more hi-strength steel have lowered the weight; yet the frame is actually 10% more rigid than the outgoing model.

The stretched body on the new Silverado translates to more room inside the cab-starting with added 3-inches of rear-seat legroom for a total of 43.4-inches which almost equals the 44.5-inches available to the front seat driver and passenger. Also up front, by going with a traditional gear shift lever, the entire centre console/armrest is a massive storage space organized into several transforming spaces that will accommodate pretty much anything your daily life requires along with all the electrical inputs and outlets necessary to run them. The interior itself is better seen, then described. However, it is, without a doubt, the best interior Chevy has ever put forward.

An exciting development in fuel efficiency for this new gen is a technology called Dynamic Fuel Management. Unlike the current Active Fuel Management (which runs as either an 8-cylinder or 4-cylinder), the new DFM can fire on as few as two cylinders. Studies have shown that under normal usage a DFM-equipped engine was running on less than eight cylinders 60% of the time. This translates to a 9% improvement in fuel efficiency over the old AFM system. Gas engines include updated versions of the 5.3L and 6.2L V8's along with a all new 2.7L turbo engine that is now the base engine on the highvolume Silverado LT and RST. It offers 22% more torque and greater fuel efficiency that the 4.3L V6. However this V6 and the 5.3L V8 will still the chief options on the entry-level and WT models.

The Lyon Museum is a venue that really gives you a reason to return in order not to miss the rotating displays.

General Lyon believes that all the perfect condition aircraft and automobiles in his collection operate including the historic vintage planes. the front and rear wheels. Backseat passengers benefit the most with almost limo-like legroom. Sixfooters will have no problem stretching out. Trunk space is also larger this year at 16.7 cu-ft. The 2018 Accord is even better suited now for long family vacations.

Buyers get a choice of drive trains to get them to wherever they are headed. Most will choose a turbocharged, 1.5-liter, 192 hp., four-cylinder engine that's teamed with a CVT-continuously variable (automatic) transmission. A 252 hp., 2.0 turbo, mated to a 10-speed automatic, is a higher performance alternative. My test car had this latter combo, and it responded with authority when I hit the gas.

Honda now offers the Accord in five levels of trim, LX, Sport, EX, EX-L and Touring. (A hybrid model is on the way.) The LX is pretty basic, but it does come with automatic air conditioning. Enthusiasts will, no doubt, gravitate to the Accord Sport, which provides a choice of engines and an optional six-speed manual transmission. The EX offers more features, like a moonroof and blind-spotwarning. The EX-Ladds leather upholstery, and the Touring includes everything offered in the Accord lineup.

As for safety equipment, all Accords come with the Honda Sensing system. It includes

forward collision warning and braking, adaptive cruise control and active lane monitoring. Blindspot warning and rear cross-traffic alert are also included on most models.

Behind the wheel, the Accord drives more like a European sedan, rather than one from Japan. The steering is taut, quick and responsive. The Accord reacts immediately to your input. The suspension, which is adjustable on the Touring models, like my test car, enables the driver to slice through corners with confidence. Additionally, drivers can select a "sport" mode that tightens up the steering further; increases throttle response and alters the shift pattern (automatic transmission) for an even more aggressive driving. On the flip side, the ride quality on the Touring, which comes with 19-inch wheels, will bounce you around on back roads. Other models, with 17-inchers should be more compliant.

Accord pricing is in line with other midsize sedans. The base LX goes for \$24,565. The Sport is \$26,775. The EX comes in at \$28,365 and the EX-L is \$2,500 more. At the top of the line is the Touring, which will set you back \$36,690 with the two-liter engine. **SNAPSHOT REVIEW**

tion of 1500-series pickup is becoming more and more towing capable. This is regardless of brand. They tow more weight, handle larger trailers and, thankfully, the builders are adding the tech and safety features needed to handle these larger loads safely. It's actually funny that many of us still refer to this size of truck as "half-tons" - we left that territory long ago.

The new numbers for the 2019 Silverado are 12,200 lb - towing (max), up 400 lb over 2018. New maximum payload has increase 340 lb to a hefty 2,500 lb. Now to handle these new weights Chevy has added some very welcome and slick towing technologies. First, up to four cameras offer continued on page 19

continued from page 4 side-impact and throrax for front and rear outboard seating positions and knee air bags for the driver and front passenger; a standard rear-vision camera; Side Blind Zone Alert with Lane Change Alert and Rear Cross-Traffic Alert. Driver Confidence Package 2 is available with Adaptive Cruise Control, Following Distance Indicator, Forward Collision Alert, Forward Automatic Braking, Lane Keep Assist, Front Pedestrian Braking and head-up display.

The front transversely-mounted engine is a 3.6-liter, DOHC, 24-valve, VVT V-6 with Direct Injection and auto Stop/Start that delivers 310 horsepower at 6,800 rpm while also developing 282 pound feet of torque at 5,200 rpm. The AWD powertrain is essentially a transplant from the larger and heavier Buick LaCrosse.

My 2018 Buick Regal GS AWD test vehicle came with a base price of \$39,065., with the as tested price rising to \$44,110. After factoring in the Driver Confidence Package #2, Power Moonroof, Sights and Sounds Package, Appearance Package and Destination charge. The exterior wore a coat of Sport Red, while the interior was done in Ebony with Ebony accents.

SUMMARY: Piloting the 2018 Buick Regal GS AWD vielded a peaceful and stable competence in a variety of driving scenarios from inner city to bustling freeways. Acceleration is obviously far superior to the former four-banger power plant, and the nine-speed automatic intuitively chose the proper gear in virtually all levels of spirited driving situations.

Reining in the Regal GS courtesy of the four-piston Brembo front brakes was smooth and confidence inspiring.

This latest iteration of the Regal GS is truly worthy of the Gran Sport badging. It is stylishly appealing and the performance levels are enjoyable across the board from simply commuting to a challenging romp on twisting back roads.

The 2019 Ridgeline's cabin looks good, with a comfortable and stylish feel to it. It has the largest and most flexible cabin in the midsize pickup truck segment. Not only that, but the Ridgeline is rated to carry 1,584lb. of cargo-hauling and tow up to 5000-lb

There are plenty of features and the technology base of the Ridgelines offering is certainly up-to-date. For instance, you get an eight-inch display touchscreen which has Android Auto and Apple CarPlay integration.

The standard climate control system is three-zone and automatic. The driver gets an eightway power driver's seat with adjustable lumbar support. Folks sitting in back then are not forgotten when it comes to comfort. In addition to the third-zone climate control, the rear seats are actually comfortable for adults. The legroom is good, and the rear doors open wide enough for easy in-and-out hopping by those of any age.

So, this is a vehicle which can easily function as a family crossover ute. Let's face it, the

word sophisticated isn't one usually used in association with the words "pickup truck." But it is an acceptable description of the Ridgeline's interior.

But there's even more "social" capability behind the back seat. In that regard, the truck bed of the Ridgeline is somewhat special. While you may not carry a ton of coal in it, you will probably delight in its use in social situations. If you are going to be tailgating at sporting events, picnics or other gatherings you've got a couple of special features.

First the tailgate is dual-action, opening down or to the side. Then there is a lockable and weathersealed storage area Honda calls the In-Bed Trunk, as well as a 115V AC power outlet. But the big deal for this purpose is the optional and world's first Truck Bed Audio System. It literally uses the sides of the bed liner as speakers, producing pretty decent sound quality. In addition to sounding pretty good, it is just so cool a feature that it's worth the price just for the show-off value.

But there is a down side to being based on a crossover platform. While it is available in two-wheel drive version, the two wheels that are driven are the front two. While there's nothing wrong with that, it continued on page 8

miles per gallon. Not bad for the varied driving conditions provided to us as we maneuvered downtown traffic, hills and back roads with various road surfaces.

The three available drive modes (Normal, Sport and Smart) demonstrated differences that were discernible. When the Smart position was chosen the programmed shift-points and steering stiffness actually improved. Not the best Eco mode as the Normal mode, but defiantly the most fun.

The new Forte is stiffer than the second generation that it replaces. The frame is 26% more rigid thanks to the utilization of advanced high-strength steel. At 2,707 pounds, the new Forte is the lightest of all compact cars on the market.

Noise, vibration and harshness is improved noticeably when driving over uneven surfaces or experiencing potholes or other surprises encountered on the road

trip. An example of the quiet factor is 4mm-thick glass, an increase that contributes to noise reduction of 5 decibels from the outgoings Forte.

Braking is one of the highlights of this 2019 Forte. Even with spirited driving stopping was effortless. The amount of force required was easy and smooth even after an all day drive.

The FE model with manual transmission is priced at \$17,690. The FE with the IVT transmission starts at \$18,585. The EX trim edition with additional advanced driver-assistance systems like lane change assist, blind-spot collision warning and rear cross-traffic alert is \$21,990. A special EX Launch Edition model will be available later this year that will begin at \$26,095.

The 2019 Kia Forte is a stand out in the compact car arena. Kia hopes this new Forte will continue to be the choice of first time buyers

is not a discussion you want to get into when somebody asks if drives all four wheels.

All 2019 Honda Ridgelines are powered by a 3.5-liter, directinjected V-6 engine with variable valves and variable cylinder management. It sends its 280 hp. and 262 lb.-ft. of peak torque through a six-speed automatic transmission. Not being a bodyon-frame truck helps with the Ridgelines efficiency. EPA mileage ratings are 19 mpg city and 26 mpg on the highway for the FWD version and 18 mpg in the city and 25 mpg on the highway for the AWD.

All Ridgelines get a buttonoperated Intelligent Traction Management system that enables up to four different operating modes: Normal, Snow, Mud and Sand for the AWD models, as well as Normal and Snow for front-wheel drive versions. The all-wheeldrive versions use Honda's Intelligent Variable Torque Management to give it better all-weather performance and handling.

Ridgeline, like you would expect, still offers the Honda Sensing suite of advanced safety and driver assistive features, including Collision Mitigation Braking System with Forward Collision Warning, lane keeping assist, Road Departure Mitigation with Lane Departure Warning, and adaptive cruise control.

This generation of the Ridgeline looks more like a conventional pickup truck than the previous version. The results are still out on this, as people who like the previous version really liked its "unique" design. But what-ever you think of the looks of this vehicle it plays a rather unique role in its positioning.

The hugely popular crossover sport utes look and perform rather like trucks, but without the limitations of the mechanical aspects of being a truck. The Ridgeline does somewhat the same thing in the pickup truck world. What the El Camino tried to do decades ago - make a pickup out of a car, may have been done very successfully with the Ridgeline.

The 2019 model is on sale now and starts at \$29,990.

continued from page 3 stance and upscale appearance. The revised styling of the front and rear of the vehicle is enhanced with the newly available LED headlights, fog lights and taillights.

The lower trim levels start in the mid \$20k's. Trim levels are LX, EX, SX and the fully loaded SLX — a \$48,370 all-wheel drive that I drove for this review. Before you decide the price is high, keep in mind that this SLX Sorento was optioned to luxury specification levels and the value is fantastic.

A quiet, refined drive was welcome in the Sorento on our trip to Walla Walla. The 3.3-liter V6 is coupled with a new eightspeed automatic transmission. A few other options that made the drive enjoyable are the Smart Cruise Control with Stop and Go to help maintain a predetermined distance from a vehicle in front of you, Driver Attention Warning, Lane Keeping Assist, Blind Spot Detection and Forward Collision Warning.

The designated driver deserved an extremely comfortable 14way power adjustable driver's seat with perfect lumbar support. Soft nappa leather seating is throughout the vehicle. The interior fit and finish is beautiful and especially noticeable on the doors accented with double stitching and chrome. The attractive dashboard includes an excellent control layout with easy to operate touchscreen, tuning and volume knobs along with clearly marked air controls. The console was designed with trays to hold many small items like keys, phones and coins with a compartment in the middle large enough to stash a small purse. Cup holders are located in all doors as well as the console.

The three-row, seven person seating is perfect for a group to tour the wineries. Since it is a squeeze for adults to fit in the third row and that seating doesn't accommodate long legs, you will want to find two short, flexible friends to sit in the third row. All passengers have available cup holders and wireless charging ports are included for occupants of the three rows of seating. A panoramic roof with a sun shade gives the Sorento's passengers plenty of light and offers skyward views.

Our destination in Walla Walla was the Cougar Crest Estate Winery which is located on Frenchtown Road off Highway 12 in the Westside wine region of the Walla Walla valley. We had fond memories of visiting the winery in their early years at the beginning of this century when they were located at the Walla Walla Airport. Ten years ago the winery moved into a beautiful new building that contains a subterranean wine cellar and is made from Rastra blocks, a recycled material consisting of recycled polystyrene mixed with concrete. The environmentally friendly building exemplifies the sustainable practices the winery practices from vineyard to production. An impressive tasting room is located in the building which is decorated with beautiful woods, fireplace, and plenty of seating for sipping wonderful wines.



2018 Toyota Sequoia Test Drive Report

The 2018 Toyota Sequoia, as big and as mighty as the Sequoia trees that it's named after. The Sequoia is one of the few remaining "body-on-frame" SUVs and is the perfect SUV if you want bul-letproof reliability, tons of space for the family, and loads of towing capacity. However, if you're looking for great fuel economy and tons of technology gadgets, you might want to look elsewhere.

For the 2018 model, Toyota came out with significant changes in the Sequoia. Encompassed in those are: styling updates, a new TRD Sport trim, and a slew of new safety features (forward collision warning, automatic braking, lane departure warning, parking sensors, blind-spot monitoring, and traffic-adaptive cruise control, to name a few). Our test model was the new TRD Sport, which featured more aggressive styling, sport-tuned suspension, a blacked out front grille, mirror caps, and rear badging, darkened rear tail light housing, and black 20 inch rims wrapped in a more aggressive off road tire.

Driving Dynamics:

In regards to driving dynamics, the Sequoia is able to perform both in the city, and off road. The large seats are extremely comfortable and the rear cabin can easily seat adults in the middle and rear rows. The cabin was very quiet at highways speeds, and the vehicle cruises comfortably down the road as if you're riding in a luxury car. As to be expected, parallel parking in a city setting can be cumbersome in the Sequoia, but a rear view camera and parking sensors are there to assist you. Not to mention the turning radius is superb for a vehicle of its size and stabilizer bars in the front and rear keep body roll to a minimum.

Once off road, the Sequoia easily traveled down trails with its Bilstein shocks, offering a comfortable ride that a baby could sleep through. The 10 inches of ground clearance allows you to pass over small obstacles with ease. I didn't try any trails extreme enough, but there are multiple 4wd modes and a locking center differential on the TRD Sport for all of your off roading needs.

Interior:

The interior, as mentioned, is massive and luxurious. The large 10-way adjustable heated leather seats in the front and large knobs make the Sequoia ideal for driving to your annual ski trip. The TRD Sport features second row captain's seating and a seating capacity of 7, while other trims seat 8. The 6.1-inch touch-screen display can be a bit small at times, but Toyota's Entune infotainment system lays everything out in a intuitive design. The Sequoia also features bluetooth, HD Radio, satellite

radio, voice recognition and all of the other amenities you would expect from a 2018 vehicle.

If you need cargo space, the Sequoia has plenty of it. Behind the third-row seats there is 18.9 cubic feet of space, fold down the third row with the push of a button and the space increases to 66.6 cubic feet, fold down the second row, and you have a huge 120.1 cubic foot area to work with. We used the Sequoia to bring all of the materials we needed to our Legends of Auto venue, and we didn't even need to fold all of the seats down!

Ride & Drive: Fiat 500L and Bear Creek Golf Course (Winthrop, Wash.)

Let's start with cutting edge design, segment leading value (\$23,325 base MSRP), above average fuel economy 30 mph hiway/ 22 mph city and 25 mph overall, 15 functional standard safety features including LATCH Ready Child SeatAnchor system and Park View Rear Back Up Camera.

Powered with a 1.4-Liter I4 MultiAir Turbo Engine mated 6-speed Automatic Transmission gives you more than enough "power-to-pass." If your looking for a fun-to-drive compact CUV I suggest a test drive.

Your drives on the 9 hole Bear Creek golf course located in the Methow Valley outside of Winthrop, WA will land on well

groomed fairways. Bear Creek is managed by Laurie and Mike Hilton. Their two daughters also help around the club house when they are not in school or on the course. The snack bar offers food & beverages. There are separate tees when you tee it up for the second nine. The 18 hole yardage is 6,271 years from the men's tees and 5,310 yards from the ladies tees. We recommend Bear Creek at Winthrop, WA as part of your Northwest hiking, cycling, camping, fishing, hunting, river rafting, or your road-trip vacation in Eastern, WA. directional information. Power options on the Limited include wireless phone charging located on a shelf on the console, tilt and telescoping power steering wheel with memory, premium leather heated and vented front seats including heated rear seats, 8-way power driver seat and passenger seat is 4-way with lumbar support. An additional feature is the Smart experience and it delivers a rich, uncompromised listening experience from any music source. This system features over 14 speakers throughout the vehicle. The only thing I felt was missing was a cd player.

To sum it up this a luxury sedan with great value that won't break the bank. Don't make the mistake of not visiting your Toyota dealer for a test drive of the new 2019 Avalon Limited Hybrid.

continued from page 3 It really is an all-in-one package if you need a mid-size commercial vehicle. Imagine the impact 22 mpg could have on your bottomline instead of the 10-14 mpg older full-size vans and trucks get! Driving Dynamics and Review:

The Metris is powered by a 2.0 liter inline 4 turbo engine. This little power plant pumps out 208 hp and 258 ft-lbs of torque to the rear wheels. Mated with a 7 speed automatic, the Metris got up to speed plenty fast enough for a work truck. The steering in the Metris was very responsive and I feels like you're driving a C300 instead of a cargo van. I was able to make u-turns, maneuver through traffic, and cut through tight alley ways with ease. Parallel parking was also simple with the standard equipped back-up camera. One thing I did desire was larger side mirrors. A small factor, but one that was noticeable as I had the model with no side or rear windows. Another concern that many people have brought up is the required use of premium gas. Mercedes has mitigated this issue with the 2018 model, as the Metris is now capable of taking any type of gasoline you use. Since the fuel tank is only 18.5 gallons, I was able to fill up the Metris with just \$50.

Being a work van, the interior of the Metris is nothing extraordinary. The dashboard is made of standard plastic material, and the seats, while comfortable, are simply seats. If you live in a cold climate, heated-seats are an option that is available and the steering wheel is made of high quality material that is nice to grip. The standard stereo has good acoustics, and does have bluetooth capability which is a nice touch for calls between job sites. At the end of the day though, the main focus of the Metris design is functionality, and that is something it does well.

With regards to price, the Metris starts at just \$26,570. A price-tag that I was shocked to discover was that low. From my perspective, if you're looking at purchasing a new commercial vehicle, it doesn't make sense to not consider the Metris! Make sure to stop by Mercedes-Benz of Lynnwood to check-out the 2018 model!

Multiple Story Lines Unfold in Captivating AMERICA'S **TIRE 250 to Conclude Continental Tire Monterey Grand Prix**

Wild races decided in IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Challenge

The buildup from the incredible finish to last year's AMERICA'S TIRE 250 and the previous day's Continental Tire SportsCar Challenge 120 set a high standard for the feature event of this weekend's Continental Tire Monterey Grand Prix, and teams from the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship again rose to the occasion at WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca with an unpredictable race that entertained fans and viewers from start to finish.

In a wild two-hour and 40minute penultimate round of the 2018 IMSA WeatherTech Sports-Car Championship, No. 22 Tequila Patrón ESM Nissan DPi co-drivers Pipo Derani and Johannes van Overbeek rebounded from early setbacks to score their second victory of the season. Nissan's momentum at WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca was sustained from two weeks earlier when the racing heritage of Nissan and Datsun was celebrated at the Rolex Monterey Motorsports Reunion.

Van Överbeek started the car from the rear of the Prototype grid as he missed Saturday's qualifying session due to illness, and he managed to avoid an opening-lap incident that removed the No. $\hat{5}$ Mustang Sampling Cadillac DPi-V.R driven by Joao Barbosa before the starting line and damaged several other cars. The incident affected several cars that are in championship contention in several categories.

Van Overbeek pitted to turn the car over to Derani just 22 minutes into the race. After a restart following the race's third full-course caution just 46 minutes into the race, Derani spun in Turn 2, but his Nissan DPi avoided serious damage. The Brazilian methodically worked his way forward following the spin, moving into the top five for the first time an hour and eight minutes into the race and staying there for most of the remainder of the race.

He was running second with 35 minutes remaining when race leader Harry Tincknell spun the No. 55 Mazda DPi while attempting to pass the lapped car of Gustavo Yacaman. Derani inherited the lead as a result and never was challenged for the rest of the race en route to victory. He won by 10.9 seconds over Colin Braun in the No. 54 CORE autosport ORECALMP2 machine. "My team is amazing," Derani

said. "If it wasn't for them, we wouldn't have finished where we finished today. We had a tough race with contact and spin. They kept pushing me over the radio. Save fuel, save tires, but kept pushing me all the time.

"It was an amazing day. I had an overtake on the Corkscrew, which is nice. This team, no matter what happens they keep fighting and fighting. We've had a tough season, but here we are with two wins. We've had a lot of DNFs, but a nice race today, and an amazing finish here.'

It was the first win for Derani and van Overbeek since March's Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring Presented by Advance Auto Parts. For van Overbeek, it was his 15th IMSA win (six WeatherTech Championship, 8 American Le Mans Series, 1 GRAND-AM), and it was Derani's fifth IMSA win, all coming in WeatherTech Championship competition.

"Hats off to the Patron guys today," said van Overbeek, who also won at WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca in 2014. "They did a fantastic job. There was a lot of attrition and an uncharacteristic number of yellows today. But we fought through and Pipo did an amazing job as usual.

"The stops were spot on, the car was great, the Continental tires were great and the Nissan motor made good power. I couldn't be happier.'

Braun and co-driver Jon Bennett made huge gains in the Prototype championship chase with their runner-up result, their fourth consecutive top-two performance. With only the 10-hour Motul Petit Le Mans at Road Atlanta on Oct. 13 remaining on the schedule, Braun and Bennett now trail leaders Eric Curran and Felipe Nasr by four points, 254-250. Curran and Nasr finished fifth in Sunday's race in the No. 31 Whelen Engineering Cadillac DPi-V.R.

Juan Pablo Montoya and Dane Cameron finished third in the No. 6Acura Team Penske ARX-05 DPi car for their fourth podium result of the season. Tincknell battled back following the spin to finish fourth in the No. 55 Mazda DPi with co-driver and Monterey resident Jonathan Bomarito.

The second race of Lamborghini Super Trofeo was completed with an overall victory by JC Perez and Loris Spinelli, who won the ProAm category and finished ahead of Pro winners Trent Hindman and Jonathan Cecotto despite the lower classification. Damon Ockey (Am) and Brett Meredith (LB Cup) also notched wins. Action in Pirelli Trophy West concluded with wins by Loren Beggs (Diamond), Sean McAlister (Platinum), Tom Tait (Platinum), Ross Jaffe (Gold), Chris Bellomo (Silver) and Steve Goldman (Bronze).

In addition to the great racing, fans enjoyed a fun and educational environment in Hagerty Marketplace where the inaugural New Holland Ag Day was held with tractors, hay bales and a bluegrass performance. Autograph sessions, a grid walk and other activities around the paddock entertained and delighted amid a gorgeous Monterey County day.



Mecum Monterey 2018 Daytime Auction Reaches ^{\$}47 Million in Overall Sales

10th Anniversary Auction Achieves 38-Percent Growth in Sales Over 2017

Mecum Auctions outdid itself again with a 38-percent increase in total sales at its 10th annual Daytime Auction held in Monterey, California. With quality, rarity and diversity punctuating the vast Mecum lineup, the 2018 auction hurdled past last year's totals as overall sales reached an impressive \$47 million and marked the anniversary event as the highest-grossing Monterey auction in Mecum's 10 years on the peninsula. In all, 394 exceptional autos changed hands in just three days, Aug. 23-25, and even individual sales prices reflected the strength of the auction's stellar lineup.

Including everything from prewar luxury motorcars to racing legends and modern hypercars, top sales at the Daytime Auction fittingly represent the astonishing cross-section of multimilliondollar investment-grade autos offered throughout the three-day event. The auction's top seller was an absolutely stunning 1933 Duesenberg Model J Convertible Coupe Disappearing Top Roadster (Lot S93) that sold for \$3.85 million, while the second top slot was claimed by a 307-mile 2014 hybrid-drive Ferrari LaFerrari (Lot S111) that brought \$3.19 million. The auction's diverse lineup was further highlighted by the sales of a 2003 Ferrari Enzo (Lot S48.1) that brought \$2.86 million and a 1989 Porsche 962 (Lot S126) that sold for \$2.2 million. Another Duesenberg to land among top sales was the 1929 Model J Convertible Sedan (Lot S116.1) of the headlining Academy of Art University Collection. The car brought a \$1.155 million sale, taking the prestigious school's entire seven-car offering to \$2.82 million overall as all vehicles in the group hammered sold.

Unique sales that drew substantial attention from the public included the \$1.127 million sale of the Indy 500-winning 2012 Dallara DW12 Honda Indy Car (Lot S90). The car was offered with an unusual engine lease agreement that will allow the new owner to take possession of the car's racewinning power plant—something that is virtually unheard of in the world of factory-sponsored racing. The 1987 Porsche 959 Komfort (Lot F109.1) offered on Friday was another vehicle that became an attraction unto itself, and its sale at \$467,500 demonstrated that its unbridled potential was unquestionably evident. The 1985 Modena GT Spyder California (Lot S189) featured in "Ferris Bueller's Day Off" demanded serious attention as well, and heated bidding brought its final selling price to \$407,000.

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
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
