
Mecum's Motorcycle Auction Scheduled for Jan. 22-27th in Las Vegas, Nevada

For more than 50 years, Christer R. Christensson has been collecting motorcycles, resulting in a world-renowned collection that is both extensive and representative of the very best of the best when it comes to motorcycle design and technology. Working alongside his colleague, Ove Johannson, and his highly skilled team of restorers, Christensson has built the MC Collection of Stockholm into a more than 400-motorcycle presentation that establishes the motorcycle

not merely as a machine, but as a contemporary work of art and mechanical sculpture. The collection pays homage to the design engineers and motorcycles that have shaped the industry for more than 100 years, starting with the very first motorcycle produced, the Hildebrand & Wolfmüller of 1894. Christensson re-housed his unique personal collection in 1999 in a showroom near Stockholm built to both serve his collection's needs and to share a selection of about 140 of his motorcycles with the general public, providing an opportunity for enthusiasts to closely study the motorcycles and how they have evolved since 1894. PAST - I grew up in the car business over 5 decades ago. My dad was in the automotive lease business, an uncle of ours was the manager of a Tacoma, independent automotive parts store and a cousin owned a new car dealership also in Tacoma, WA. In high school my part time job was detailing new and used cars and when I got my drivers license I was picking up lease returns and delivering cars to the Seattle Auto Auction. The market was dominated by the "Big 3" Chevrolet, Chrysler, and Ford. V-8 engines ruled and everyone wanted more power. Interior functions were controlled with a knobs; windows, radio, heaters, etc. All new models were introduced at dealerships the second or third weekend in September. The auto industry was simple and easy to understand in those days.

PRESENT - So fast forward 50 years. Imports have arrived from Asia, Europe, and other global automakers. Automotive designers have delivered rolling art. Engineers have created smaller engines with less emissions and better MPG. Technology companies have increased their influence on the automaker decision process. When the Toyota RAV4 was introduced in 1994 it created the small SUV segment. Who would have guessed that twenty-five years later the RAV4 would lead the now crowded small SUV segment, passing up the best selling sedan in the market, the Camry.

We have known for many years the bestselling vehicle in America is a full size truck and not a passenger car. Just when the buying public got used to hearing the bestselling car is a truck, the second best seller now is a crossover or small SUV. The RAV4 claims that title as the nation's top-selling nonpickup truck. Sales have doubled in the last five years. Oh, how times have changed.

From a design standpoint, the new RAV4 has an all new exterior look. The new easy to identify shape shares the Toyota TNGA platform with Avalon, Camry and the new 2020 Corolla. RAV4 is 1.2-inches longer providing improved legroom for rear seat occupants. The width has increased depending on the wheel choice and the model level designation.

The 2019 Toyota RAV4 gasoline models will be available in five levels; the LE, XLE, XLE Premium, Adventure and Limited. The addition of the Hybrid version will follow next spring. Front-wheel-drive is standard and depending on the model and trim selection, the new RAV4 offers three types of all-wheel-drive systems. A segment first allwheel-drive with torque-vectoring can be included with the Limited

New from the Ground Up

Acura has pulled out all the stops with its redesigned 2019 RDX. This third-generation crossover SUV gets a new body structure, exciting styling, and a new power train, yet it still has the lowest starting price in its class.

The RDX rides on a new, stronger platform, and features a body design that is truly contemporary. The 2019 RDX sports a large pentagon-shaped grille, strong character lines on the bodywork and a "floating" roofline. The interior also sparkles. Stylish seats, clad with leather trimmed Ultrasuede catch the eye when you enter. An elaborate center control panel features a large (10.2-inch) display and an electronic gear selector.

The infotainment system is controlled by Acura's True Touchpad interface on the center console. There is a learning curve here. It operates much like your computer, and if you are patient, you will find that it becomes almost second-nature to you. I only wish there was a conventional knob for tuning the radio. I hate going through several steps to change a station.

Honda Accord **Hybrid Test Drive Review**

Honda has a complete lineup of electric vehicles including two hybrids (Accord & Insight) a pure electric Clarity, a plugin Hybrid Clarity and the Clarity fuel cell. My test drive report is for this issue is the "fun-to-drive" Honda Accord Hybrid, the flagship in Honda's electric car lineup. Key available features include:

- 252 hp 2.0 liter, turbo charged and intercooled VTEC engine
- Head-up Display with a Wireless phone charger
- Heated and ventilated front

The midsize sedan has a base MSRP of \$24,500 and up to \$36,000 depending on options. You will like the fuel economy rating of 28/42 MPH and the 5 Star NHTSA safety rating. With a 3 year/36,000 mile warranty, lower basic MSRP and above average MPG the Honda Accord Hybrid carries a "best value rating." The Honda Accord Hybrid is considered my most to be one of the best designed hybrids, with lots of room and it is "fun-to-drive."

Trucks, currently, have never been more important to a manufacturer's bottom line. Not only because they are selling in ever increasing numbers but because there just doesn't appear to be price ceiling. Customers keep loading up new pickups with luxuries that only a few years ago were found only in sedans. For 2019 that's why we not only have an all-new generation of Silverado (the fourth since 1999) but also, simply put, more of everything.

The new Silverado now offers eight trim levels, six different engine and transmission combinations – and for the first time – a new Duramax 3.0L turbo-diesel.

Though this next-gen Silverado is larger than its predecessor (1.2inches wider, 1.5-inches taller, 1.7-inches longer, with 3.9-inches added to the wheelbase) it is lighter by some 450 lb. A mixed materials

With the approval of the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, commercial vehicle tax deductions are more favorable than ever. If you're in the market for a new commercial vehicle and you work in an industry where you need to haul tools and materials through small alleyways and city streets while getting 22 mpg, look no further than the Mercedes-Benz Metris. What is The Metris?

For my review this issue, Mercedes-Benz of Lynnwood was kind enough to loan me a 2018 Metris Cargo van. After driving it for a few days, I can say I'm impressed!

Since its release in 2015, the Metris has been positioned as a mid-size commercial van. It's smaller than its Sprinter brother, but bigger than vehicles like the Nissan NV200 and Ford Transit Connect. Because of this, the Metris is able to boast an 186 cubic-foot cargo space, 5000 lb towing capacity, qualify for the 100% depreciation tax benefit with its 6,750 lb GVWR weight, and still astoundingly get 22 mpg.

2018 Buick Regal GS AWD Test Drive Review

Remember back when Buick was generally thought of as an entry level luxo-boat that appealed to more mature drivers? Be that as it may, that's no longer the case. The 2018 Buick Regal GS AWD is a prime example that adds: two more cylinders than before in the form of a 310 horsepower V-6 (a plus of 51 horses); a nine-speed automatic transmission; and a standard intelligent AWD system with an active twin clutch that can transfer torque between the rear wheels precisely, delivering a more refined, efficient performance and enhanced vehicle control by combating under steer as well as torque steer.

Also new is a second generation example of Continuous Damping Control that's capable of 500 adjustments per second, directed by Buick's Interactive Control allowing the driver to fine tune the vehicle's driving dynamics via three modes – a standard setting, a Sport setting, or a GS mode via a selection in the center console. There are performance brakes with Brembo front calipers.

This new 5-passenger, Buick Regal GS is a premium sport sedan that displays unique sport front and rear fascias, side skirting and a rear spoiler along with a sport-tuned exhaust system and GS badging front and rear. There's a sport-flat bottomed steering wheel and metal pedals. LED headlamps and a Head Up Display are available options. The performance seating is GS-specific, AGR certified (Germany's Aktion Gesunder Rücken, or Campaign for Healthier Backs), heated, cooled, a massaging feature with adjustable seat and seatback bolsters, along with thigh

This Buick Regal GS (which is for Gran Sport by the way) is definitely not your uncle's or grandfather's stodgy Buick of yore, but rather an aggressive exterior expression of a four door hatchback styling. It's an attractive sedan that is sure to draw the attention of more youthful consumers.

Connectivity is showcased by a cohesive infotainment system featuring an 8-inch touchscreen along with an 8-inch-diagonal, reconfigurable instrument cluster as well as Apple CarPlay and Android Auto compatibility as standard fare. The Regal GS also comes with OnStar 4G LTE Wi-Fi hotspot (with a complimentary 3-month/3GB data trial) and access to an unlimited data plan for \$20 per month.

Safety features of the Buick Regal GS include: ten standard air bags, including frontal driver/ front passenger, head-curtain

International Conference "Fuels the Future" Scheduled for January 21/22 in Berlin, Germany

International Conference on Renewable Mobility "Fuels of the Future 2019" on 21/22 January 2019 in Berlin

Negotiations on the global climate agreement in Katowice in December 2018 (COP24) mark a further milestone on the path towards the ambitious goals of limiting global warming and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. How can the transport sector, drawing on the full range of affordable technological developments, contribute to attaining climate change mitigation objectives? The increasing diversification of drive technologies, along with production and use of renewable fuels, constitute challenges for sustainable renewable mobility, yet also provide the key to achieving the targets. There is an increased emphasis in the conference programme on drive technologies, as well as on differentiating between various fuel options.

The extensive programme offers

a variety of topics with relevance for increasing climate protection in individual and heavy goods traffic, as well as in the fields of aviation and shipping.

On the opening day, the focus will be on mobility, set between the conflicting priorities of climate protection, economic efficiency and user acceptance. In the plenary session, representatives from the Federal Ministry of Transport and Digital Infrastructure, the European Parliament, the petroleum and automotive industries and the scientific community will discuss future prospects for the transport sector.

The panel discussion will pick up on statements made by industry, politics, European agriculture and the environmental organisation WWF. Sonja van Renssen, Energy Post editor, will chair a discussion between Pekka Pesonen (COPA-COGECA), Dr. Klaus Bonhoff (National Organisation for Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Technology), Dr. Ruprecht Brandis (BP Europe

SE), Jenny Walther-Thoss (WWF Germany) and Stefan Schreiber (Cargill Holding Germany) on the future of renewable mobility in the light of various drive and fuel options. The afternoon forum will analyse future prospects for synthetic fuels.

On the second day of the conference, 11 forums will examine a broad spectrum of topics from all areas of renewable energy in the mobility sector: German and international experts will present news on technical developments, research, certification, market analysis and trade flows, as well as entering into discussions with conference participants. These forums, like the exhibitor forum with exhibition stands, will also offer scope for professional exchanges and networking. Again more than 500 delegates from more than 25 countries are expected.

approach to construction is the reason for this. Strategic use of aluminum and more hi-strength steel have lowered the weight; yet the frame is actually 10% more rigid than the outgoing model.

The stretched body on the new Silverado translates to more room inside the cab-starting with added 3-inches of rear-seat legroom for a total of 43.4-inches which almost equals the 44.5-inches available to the front seat driver and passenger. Also up front, by going with a traditional gear shift lever, the entire centre console/armrest is a massive storage space organized into several transforming spaces that will accommodate pretty much anything your daily life requires along with all the electrical inputs and outlets necessary to run them. The interior itself is better seen, then described. However, it is, without a doubt, the best interior Chevy has ever put forward.

An exciting development in fuel efficiency for this new gen is a technology called Dynamic Fuel Management. Unlike the current Active Fuel Management (which runs as either an 8-cylinder or 4-cylinder), the new DFM can fire on as few as two cylinders. Studies have shown that under normal usage a DFM-equipped engine was running on less than eight cylinders 60% of the time. This translates to a 9% improvement in fuel efficiency over the old AFM system. Gas engines include updated versions of the 5.3L and 6.2L V8's along with a all new 2.7L turbo engine that is now the base engine on the highvolume Silverado LT and RST. It offers 22% more torque and greater fuel efficiency that the 4.3L V6. However this V6 and the 5.3L V8 will still the chief options on the entry-level and WT models.

Most truck owners know, and certainly sense, that each generation of 1500-series pickup is becoming more and more towing capable. This is regardless of brand. They tow more weight, handle larger trailers and, thankfully, the builders are adding the tech and safety features needed to handle these larger loads safely. It's actually funny that many of us still refer to this size of truck as "half-tons" – we left that territory long ago.

The new numbers for the 2019 Silverado are 12,200 lb - towing (max), up 400 lb over 2018. New maximum payload has increase 340 lb to a hefty 2,500 lb. Now to handle these new weights Chevy has added some very welcome and slick towing technologies. First, up to four cameras offer continued on page 19

Chevrolet | Lyon Museum Displays Dan Gurney's Race Cars

The Lyon Air Museum is the only venue in Orange County on John Wayne Airport's active runway. Featuring authentic aircraft, along with rare vehicles and related memorabilia. This 30,000 square foot hanger is home to over a half a dozen original aircraft that defines the important role the United States played in shaping world history.

Vintage vehicles include Military automobiles and Vintage vehicles mostly from the collection of the founder, Major General William Lyon, USAF (retired). The mission of Lyon Air Museum is to provide a world-class avenue of inspiration where the stories of aviation's past can touch the lives of its visitors through educational exhibits, authentic historical aircraft and related memorabilia.

The fun for auto enthusiasts are the cars that are displayed throughout the museum. These vehicles are positioned between the aircraft on a floor that could rival a surface to eat from. General Lvon has been known for his exceptional car collection. Mostly housed at his home in Coto de Caza, Southern California, the restored classic vehicles add much color and excitement to his air museum as well.

As is expected of major car collections, the exhibits are rotated regularly providing the opportunity to revisit the museum to eventually experience the majority of the Lyon car collection. The rarity and exceptional condition of the automobiles have earned the Lyon collection first place and best of show accolades at many of the most prestigious car events.

Currently on display is a special exhibit featuring the race cars of the renowned race car driver and performance car builder, the late Dan Gurney. The Formula 1 racer, adds to the legend of one of the best known and popular racers of all time. Some of the best history in the Lyon Museum is currently the race cars of Dan Gurney. The Lyon Museum is a venue that really gives you a reason to return in order not to miss the rotating displays.

General Lyon believes that all the perfect condition aircraft and automobiles in his collection operate including the historic vintage planes. All planes, mostly WWII, are flown by people that know them well. All cars are kept in run-ready condition in order to participate in an exercise drill at moment's notice.

Not all cars are concours material. A Helms bakery truck is a highlight for Southern California residents who remember the neighborhood daily service of fresh bakery goods. For the kids, the interactive section of the museum provides a place for kids, with parental supervision, to climb up, in and out of trucks and Jeeps.

The new RDX is a couple of inches longer now, but more importantly, the distance between the front and rear wheels is longer too. This means there is more cabin space, and a larger cargo area. Rear passengers benefit with a bit more legroom, and cargo space is at the top of its class at nearly 30 cubic feet.

Acura shelved the old V-6 engine this year, and replaced it with a 2.0liter turbocharged four. The turbo cranks out 272 hp., and delivers a robust growl. It's teamed with a slick-shifting 10-speed automatic transmission that drives either the front wheels, or all four wheels. Acura's SH-AWD all-wheel drive returns this year as an option. Gas mileage is 24 mpg with front-wheel drive, and 23 mpg with AWD, about average for this class.

Acura offers the RDX with three different trim packages, Technology, A-Spec and Advance that enhance the standard version. However, most buyers should be happy with the standard RDX. It's well-equipped with a panoramic moonroof, nine-speaker audio, adaptive cruise control, forward collision warning and braking, as well as lane-departure monitoring and intervention.

However, if you want more,


the Technology package, adds a 12-speaker sound system, navigation, blind spot monitoring and rear cross-traffic alert. The sportier A-Spec provides 20-inch wheels, 16 speakers and black exterior trim. The Advance goes even further with an adaptable suspension, head-up display and a surroundview camera.

Behind the wheel, The RDX is engaging to drive. My A-Spec test car with AWD felt responsive and sure-footed on twisty country roads. Drivers can select four different drive settings, Comfort, Sport, Sport+ and Snow. Comfort is the default mode, and the other three adjust steering feel, throttle response and the transmission shift points. I found the Sport mode sharpened the responses just the right amount on my favorite test route. However, even in the Comfort setting, the ride is a bit stiff. But, if you were to choose the Advance package, with the adaptable suspension, it might be cushier.

The RDX pricing starts at a reasonable \$38,295 for the standard model with front-wheel drive. When the Technology package is added, it's \$41,495. A-Spec jumps it up to \$43,495, and the Advance is \$46.395. All-wheel drive adds another \$2,000.

side-impact and throrax for front and rear outboard seating positions and knee air bags for the driver and front passenger; a standard rear-vision camera; Side Blind Zone Alert with Lane Change Alert and Rear Cross-Traffic Alert. Driver Confidence Package 2 is available with Adaptive Cruise Control, Following Distance Indicator, Forward Collision Alert, Forward Automatic Braking, Lane Keep Assist, Front Pedestrian Braking and head-up display.

The front transversely-mounted engine is a 3.6-liter, DOHC, 24-valve, VVT V-6 with Direct Injection and auto Stop/Start that delivers 310 horsepower at 6,800 rpm while also developing 282 pound feet of torque at 5,200 rpm. The AWD powertrain is essentially a transplant from the larger and heavier Buick LaCrosse.

My 2018 Buick Regal GS AWD test vehicle came with a base price of \$39,065., with the as tested price rising to \$44,110. After factoring in the Driver Confidence Package #2, Power Moonroof, Sights and Sounds Package, Appearance Package and Destination charge. The exterior wore a coat of Sport Red, while the interior was done in Ebony with Ebony accents.

SUMMARY: Piloting the 2018 Buick Regal GS AWD yielded a peaceful and stable competence in a variety of driving scenarios from inner city to bustling freeways. Acceleration is obviously far superior to the former four-banger power plant, and the nine-speed automatic intuitively chose the proper gear in virtually all levels of spirited driving situations.

Reining in the Regal GS courtesy of the four-piston Brembo front brakes was smooth and confidence inspiring.

This latest iteration of the Regal GS is truly worthy of the Gran Sport badging. It is stylishly appealing and the performance levels are enjoyable across the board from simply commuting to a challenging romp on twisting back roads.

The 2019 Ridgeline's cabin looks good, with a comfortable and stylish feel to it. It has the largest and most flexible cabin in the midsize pickup truck segment. Not only that, but the Ridgeline is rated to carry 1,584lb. of cargo-hauling and tow up

There are plenty of features and the technology base of the Ridgelines offering is certainly up-to-date. For instance, you get an eight-inch display touchscreen which has Android Auto and Apple CarPlay integration.

The standard climate control system is three-zone and automatic. The driver gets an eightway power driver's seat with adjustable lumbar support. Folks sitting in back then are not forgotten when it comes to comfort. In addition to the third-zone climate control, the rear seats are actually comfortable for adults. The legroom is good, and the rear doors open wide enough for easy in-and-out hopping by those of

So, this is a vehicle which can easily function as a family crossover ute. Let's face it, the

word sophisticated isn't one usually used in association with the words "pickup truck." But it is an acceptable description of the Ridgeline's interior.

But there's even more "social" capability behind the back seat. In that regard, the truck bed of the Ridgeline is somewhat special. While you may not carry a ton of coal in it, you will probably delight in its use in social situations. If you are going to be tailgating at sporting events, picnics or other gatherings you've got a couple of special features.

First the tailgate is dual-action, opening down or to the side. Then there is a lockable and weathersealed storage area Honda calls the In-Bed Trunk, as well as a 115V AC power outlet. But the big deal for this purpose is the optional and world's first Truck Bed Audio System. It literally uses the sides of the bed liner as speakers, producing pretty decent sound quality. In addition to sounding pretty good, it is just so cool a feature that it's worth the price just for the show-off value.

But there is a down side to being based on a crossover platform. While it is available in two-wheel drive version, the two wheels that are driven are the front two. While there's nothing wrong with that, it

model. This sophisticated system is standard on the Adventure grade.

Models with conventional or the torque-vectoring all-wheel-drive include Hill Start Assist Control and Trailer Sway Control. Downhill Assist Control is standard on Adventure and Limited AWD models.

The inside story for the new SUV entry has also been redesigned. More spacious environment featuring enhanced outward visibility for all occupants add to the comfort factor. Refined interior design with more premium surface materials are welcome additions to the area where people spend most of their time. Advanced media infotainment is included in all 2019 Toyota RAV4 models. Entune 3.0, includes Wi-Fi connect along with Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant and Apple Carplay. These features assure surprise and delight experiences throughout the driving experience. Upgrading to Entune 3.0 Audio Plus adds an 8-inch touchscreen and Sirius XM radio.

For 2019, the new RAV4 is available with two engine and transmission choices. The 2.5-liter 4-cylinder engines enables the customer to choose between hybrid or standard performance. The first of these engines is a Dynamic Force 2.5-liter 4-cylinder engine that is paired with a

8-speed Direct-Shift Automatic Transmission. The second available engine is another 2.5-liter 4-cylinder that features Toyota's Hybrid System II and is connected to the Electronically-Controlled Continuously-Variable Transmission that delivers four hybrid modes for consumers to encounter.

The EPA estimates that the fuel efficiency of the 2019 Toyota RAV4 LE and Limited-FWD is 26/34/29, (city, highway, combined.) LE-AWD is rated at 26/33/29. XLE and XLE Premium-FWD are rated at 26/32/27. All grades of the RAV4 hybrid are rated at 41/37/39.

When the 2019 Toyota RAV4 gas models start arriving at dealerships next month, the LE-FWD will have a list price of \$25,500. LE-AWD starts at \$26,900 and LE HV starts at \$27,700. XLE-FWD starts at \$27,300, XLE-AWD starts at \$28,700, and XLE HV starts at \$30,900. Adventure grade starts at \$32,900. XSEHV starts at \$33,700. The 2019 Toyota RAV4 Limited-FWD starts at \$33,500, Limited - AWD starts at \$34,900 and the Limited HV starts at \$35,700.

is not a discussion you want to get into when somebody asks if drives all four wheels.

All 2019 Honda Ridgelines are powered by a 3.5-liter, directinjected V-6 engine with variable valves and variable cylinder management. It sends its 280 hp. and 262 lb.-ft. of peak torque through a six-speed automatic transmission. Not being a bodyon-frame truck helps with the Ridgelines efficiency. EPA mileage ratings are 19 mpg city and 26 mpg on the highway for the FWD version and 18 mpg in the city and 25 mpg on the highway for the AWD.

All Ridgelines get a buttonoperated Intelligent Traction Management system that enables up to four different operating modes: Normal, Snow, Mud and Sand for the AWD models, as well as Normal and Snow for front-wheel drive versions. The all-wheeldrive versions use Honda's Intelligent Variable Torque Management to give it better all-weather performance and handling.

Ridgeline, like you would expect, still offers the Honda Sensing suite of advanced safety and driver assistive features, including Collision Mitigation Braking System with Forward Collision Warning, lane keeping assist, Road Departure Mitigation with Lane Departure Warning, and adaptive cruise control.

This generation of the Ridgeline looks more like a conventional pickup truck than the previous version. The results are still out on this, as people who like the previous version really liked its "unique" design. But what-ever you think of the looks of this vehicle it plays a rather unique role in its positioning.

The hugely popular crossover sport utes look and perform rather like trucks, but without the limitations of the mechanical aspects of being a truck.

LX, EX, SX and the fully loaded SLX—a \$48,370 all-wheel drive that I drove for this review. Before you decide the price is high, keep in mind that this SLX Sorento was optioned to luxury specification levels and the value is fantastic.

A quiet, refined drive was welcome in the Sorento on our trip through the wine region. The 3.3-liter V6 is coupled with a new eight-speed automatic transmission. A few other options that made the drive enjoyable are the Smart Cruise Control with Stop and Go to help maintain a predetermined distance from a vehicle in front of you, Driver Attention Warning, Lane Keeping Assist, Blind Spot Detection and Forward Collision Warning.

The designated driver deserved the extremely comfortable 14-way power adjustable driver's seat with perfect lumbar support. Soft nappa leather seating is throughout the vehicle. The interior fit and finish is beautiful and especially noticeable on the doors accented with double stitching and chrome. The attractive dashboard includes an excellent control layout with easy to operate touchscreen, tuning and volume knobs along with clearly marked air controls. The console was designed with trays to hold many small items like keys, phones and coins with a compartment in the middle large enough to stash a small purse. Cup holders are located in all doors as well as the

The three-row, seven person seating is perfect for a group to tour the wineries. Since it is a squeeze for adults to fit in the third row and

Tagaris Winery was recognized by ZAGAT in Seattle as one of 8

wineries in the world with fabulous food. The homegrown cuisine is Mediterranean-inspired and creatively paired with their wines. Our favorite varietals of the many award-winning wines offered at Tagaris Winery include Malbec, Merlot, and Pinot Noir.

Parking at Tagaris was made easier with the Park Distance Warning, Rear Cross Traffic Collision Warning, and the Surround View Monitor that gives a 360 degree View of the vehicle's relationship to the surrounding area.

The Sorento's cargo space is easily accessible with the handsfree Smart Power lift gate opening when it senses your smart keywith no hands or feet required. 



McCormick Celebrates 33 Years in Palm Springs with 66th Collector Car Auction

After 33 years in the car auction business "You never know who or what is going to walk in the door next," said Keith McCormick, owner of McCormick's Palm Springs Collector Auction.

Since Palm Springs has been the home of many actors and TV personalities over the years, their cars often show up in the auctions held twice each year. The next auction in February 22-24, 2019, will be number 66, said Jason McCormick, who joined his father in business full time 20 years ago.

The business, which has been family owned and operated since 1985 in Palm Springs, features up to 580 vehicles at each weekend auction. The location has grown to six acres at the Palm Springs Convention Center. Under typical balmy sunshine, cars and trucks pass through the huge auction tent with seating for buyers, sellers and spectators from around the country and around the world.

McCormick's clients have ranged from King Edward VIII of England and his 1923 Rolls Royce to Bob Hope and his golf cart. Howard Hughes presented is 1969 Damlier limousine featuring a flush toilet built into the back seat. G. Gordon Liddy of Watergate fame had the license plate "H20 Gate" on his 1937 Rolls Royce Phantom.

Other celebrities have included Elvis Presley, Frank Sinatra and Telly Savalas, who once told McCormick: "I think a classy car auction would work in Palm Springs." He was right. "It is rare when a celebrity shows up at the auction, but some do," Jason McCormick said, "a couple of years ago we had Danny Koker and his crew from Counting Cars come to film part of their show at the event."

While there have been many high-end cars and trucks at the auction, and "the trend has been moving in that direction for many years," Jason McCormick said, "we still have something for everyone, with some cars selling in the \$1,500 to \$2,000 range. Some new and beginning car collectors get started at our auctions."

Each auction streams live via the Internet for three days and people who register in advance may bid for cars by phone. People tune in from across the United States, Europe and New Zealand to bid on cars. Four cameras show different views of each car as it passes through the auction tent. People bidding by telephone must register in advance and follow the same procedures as people attending the auction. Bidding requires a \$30 registration fee and a "good faith deposit," which is refunded if nothing is purchased, McCormick

Pirelli has signed an agreement with Luna Rossa Challenge for the constitution of a partnership aimed at the development of a multi-year project which will lead to Luna Rossa's participation in the next edition of the America's Cup, set for New Zealand in 2021.

Pirelli and Prada will be co-titled sponsors of the vessel and will detail their plans at a soon to be organized event.

Now in its 36th edition, the America's Cup is the oldest trophy in the history of sport, which sees the participation of the most technologically advanced boats in the world.

The project will entail, over the 4-year period 2018-2021, a series of regattas, events and activities with the two brands as protagonists. In 2019, the first two regattas of the America's Cup World Series will take place in the Mediterranean; in 2020 another three World Series regattas will be held in Europe, the United States of America and Asia; from January 2021, always in Auckland, there will be the Prada Cup, Challenger selection regattas, followed by the 36th edition of the America's Cup Presented by Prada, scheduled for March 2021.

2018 Toyota Sequoia **Test Drive** Report

The 2018 Toyota Seguoia, as big and as mighty as the Sequoia trees that it's named after. The Sequoia is one of the few remaining "body-on-frame" SUVs and is the perfect SUV if you want bulletproof reliability, tons of space for the family, and loads of towing capacity. However, if you're looking for great fuel economy and tons of technology gadgets, you might want to look elsewhere.

For the 2018 model, Toyota came out with significant changes in the Sequoia. Encompassed in those are: styling updates, a new TRD Sport trim, and a slew of new safety features (forward collision warning, automatic braking, lane departure warning, parking sensors, blind-spot monitoring, and traffic-adaptive cruise control, to name a few). Our test model was the new TRD Sport, which featured more aggressive styling, sport-tuned suspension, a blacked out front grille, mirror caps, and rear badging, darkened rear tail light housing, and black 20 inch rims wrapped in a more aggressive off road tire.

Driving Dynamics:

In regards to driving dynamics, the Sequoia is able to perform both in the city, and off road. The large seats are extremely comfortable and the rear cabin can easily seat adults in the middle and rear

rows. The cabin was very quiet at highways speeds, and the vehicle cruises comfortably down the road as if you're riding in a luxury car. As to be expected, parallel parking in a city setting can be cumbersome in the Sequoia, but a rear view camera and parking sensors are there to assist you. Not to mention the turning radius is superb for a vehicle of its size and stabilizer bars in the front and rear keep body roll to a minimum.

Once off road, the Sequoia easily traveled down trails with its Bilstein shocks, offering a comfortable ride that a baby could sleep through. The 10 inches of ground clearance allows you to pass over small obstacles with ease. I didn't try any trails extreme enough, but there are multiple 4wd modes and a locking center differential on the TRD Sport for all of your off roading needs.

Interior: The interior, as mentioned, is massive and luxurious. The large 10-way adjustable heated leather seats in the front and large knobs make the Sequoia ideal for

driving to your annual ski trip.

It really is an all-in-one package if you need a mid-size commercial vehicle. Imagine the impact 22 mpg could have on your bottomline instead of the 10-14 mpg older full-size vans and trucks get!

Driving Dynamics and Review:

The Metris is powered by a 2.0 liter inline 4 turbo engine. This little power plant pumps out 208 hp and 258 ft-lbs of torque to the rear wheels. Mated with a 7 speed automatic, the Metris got up to speed plenty fast enough for a work truck. The steering in the Metris was very responsive and I feels like you're driving a C300 instead of a cargo van. I was able to make u-turns, maneuver through traffic, and cut through tight alley ways with ease. Parallel parking was also simple with the standard equipped back-up camera.

One thing I did desire was larger side mirrors. A small factor, but one that was noticeable as I had the model with no side or rear windows. Another concern that many people have brought up is the required use of premium gas. Mercedes has mitigated this issue with the 2018 model, as the Metris is now capable of taking any type of gasoline you use. Since the fuel tank is only 18.5 gallons, I was able to fill up the Metris with just \$50.

Being a work van, the interior of the Metris is nothing extraordinary. The dashboard is made of standard plastic material, and the seats, while comfortable, are simply seats. If you live in a cold climate, heated-seats are an option that is available and the steering wheel is made of high quality material that is nice to grip. The standard stereo has good acoustics, and does have bluetooth capability which is a nice touch for calls between job sites. At the end of the day though, the main focus of the Metris design is functionality, and that is something it does well.

With regards to price, the Metris starts at just \$26,570. A price-tag that I was shocked to discover was that low. From my perspective, if you're looking at purchasing a new commercial vehicle, it doesn't make sense to not consider the Metris! Mecum Las Vegas Auction Tops \$25 Million for an Overall Increase of 7%

75 Percent of All Vehicles Hammered Sold at Three-Day, 885-Car

Mecum Auctions' second annual collector-car auction in Las Vegas was deemed a success with \$25.2 million in overall sales achieved as 667 vehicles hammered sold for a 75 percent sell-through rate. The results represent a 7 percent increase over last year's totals.

The auction-headlining Academy of Art University collection saw 31 vehicles hammer sold for an overall total of \$4 million, and four cars from the collection landed among the auction's top sellers. The University's 1930 Bugatti Type 46 Faux Cabriolet (Lot S98) boasting coachwork by Veth & Zoon came in as the auction's top sale at just more than \$1 million, and the 1930 Duesenberg Model J Dual Cowl Phaeton (Lot S130.1) brought \$770,000, landing it the No. 2 slot. A 1934 Packard 1104 Super 8 Dual Cowl Sport Phaeton (Lot S125.1) from the collection claimed the third spot in top sales, and a 1935 Pierce-Arrow Model 1245 Silver Arrow (Lot S93.1) came in as No. 6.

Other top sales included a 1970 Plymouth Hemi Cuda (Lot S145) that brought \$220,000 and Ardell Brown's 1930 Cord L-29 Cabriolet (Lot S72), which sold for \$203,500. In total, the complete Ardell Brown Estate Collection of vehicles and Road Art sold for well in excess of \$5 million.
