God's Character Frees Us to Change

God is Great, so we don't have to be in control.

God is Good, so we don't have to look elsewhere for satisfaction.

God is Gracious, so we don't have to prove ourselves.

God is Glorious, so we don't have to fear others.

As we commune together with God's in His Word, we will discover these four things about His character that in turn free us to become who we are in Christ.

Use these Four G's as a guide to answer the Four Q's: Who is God? What has He done? Who are we? How should we live? Journal what God shows and allow what you learn to inform your weekly discussion with your D Group. Together, as you wrestle through the implications of the Gospel, you will begin to see that slavery to sin comes from acting out the unbelief of one or more of these Four G's and victory from sin comes from walking in light of them.
