

## Guide for Home Groups

### **Look Back** (About 30 minutes)

Each group member chooses one of these questions to answer.

- Where did you see God at work this past week?
- Where do you need prayer/practical support?
- What Scripture or songs have been encouraging your heart this week?

### **Look Up** (About 30 minutes)

**Pray:** Ask the Spirit to speak through your conversation and the Scripture

**Read:** Take turns reading through the week's passage out loud slowly.

**Discuss:** Use these questions to understand and apply the Scripture together.

- What does this passage show us about God?
- What does this passage show us about ourselves?
- Does this passage reveal...

Sin to confess

Promises to believe

Encouragement to share

Commands to obey

Questions to explore

### **Look Forward** (About 30 minutes)

Talk and pray through ways that God is calling you to obey.

- How can we serve others this week with our time and resources?
- Who will we show/share the gospel with this week?
- Pray for specific needs represented in the group.
- Pray for specific people that your group is reaching out to.

If your group members are completing the Knowing Jesus study on their own during the week, you can have them choose a question or two from this list to discuss during the “**Look Up**” portion. Alternatively, you may want to complete one of the study days together as the group during this middle part of your time.

### **Look Up**

What questions did this week’s study or Bible text bring up for you?

What stood out to you in this week’s study?

What did you notice about God and His character?

How were you challenged by your study of the Bible text?

Is there anything you want to change in light of what you learned?

How does what you learned about God affect the way you live in community?

What correlation did you see between the psalm from Day 6 and this week’s study of Jesus and His kingdom?

What is God doing in your heart through the memory verses?

How have you felt God working in you through the weekly challenge?

How is your love for God and His Word?

Has anything you learned recently increased your joy in knowing Jesus?
