

### Easter Hope! The Basics!

Easter Hope sustains me in this crazy world we live in. My brother in Oklahoma told me this morning that a pastor friend in Ada Oklahoma was shot and killed last night. (FYI this is the hometown of Blake Shelton) My brother knew this pastor when they both served in Ada. Then, this morning I also saw on the news that a lawyer is being sued for lies she told after the last election. Her defense goes something like this. *The lies I told were so ridiculous that no reasonable person would believe them, and because they were so ridiculous, I can't be held responsible for people believing them.* (This was regarding her claim that voting machines had been rigged.) – This is the world we live in. And it isn't even 9 AM yet!

Oh, I forgot to mention, last night we learned of another shooting in Colorado, where at least 10 people were killed in a grocery store. A grocery store of all places! And these types of news stories will continue to be shared, because these types of events will continue to happen.

We truly need to get back to the basics. So, what are some basic values we hold in common? Jesus said, love God and you're your neighbor as yourself, these are the two greatest commandments. This was our theme for the Lenten season leading up to Easter. So now, after Easter, let's build on that foundation. Let's explore the basic building blocks of Jesus' own Hebrew Faith. Let's study the Top Ten List from the Bible.

There are 613 Laws in the Hebrew Bible, or what we Christians call the Old Testament. The Top Ten list is taken from those 613 total laws. So, they must be pretty important. We call them the 10 Commandments.

In 2021 we have shared a sermon series on 1) the Beatitudes of Jesus, 2) a series on the Two Greatest Commandments lifted up by Jesus, and we are now starting a sermon series on 3) the 10 Commandments God gave to us through Moses.

*Boring! The 10 Commandments are wonderful, but laws are boring.* Is that your reaction so far? If so, know that we will be looking at the 10 Commandments through the eyes of Jesus. And I guarantee you that every week we will experience seeing and understanding the commandments in a new and life-giving way. I'm looking forward to this!

These are three sermon series focused on the basics of our faith. I pray that each of these sermon series have been able to strengthen you, refresh you, and inspire you in two ways; first to accept the fact that you are worth loving and second, to share your faith and love with all those you meet. God knows this world needs to be loved.

We take comfort in John Wesley's words from his death bed, "The best of all, God is with us still."

May God's Kingdom come, on earth as it is in heaven!
