

We need to be careful to have everything in its place, or she will run right into things we leave laying on the floor. She still has trouble judging corners and occasionally will turn too early and walk into a wall. It is sad to see.

However, she still loves her three walks per day! It is remarkable to see her when she is out in the open, you can tell that she just wants to run! And, in those places where we are concerned that she will run into something, or step off a curb, she has adapted to paying attention to the slightest nudge with

the leash. She knows we are warning her of an obstacle in the area. She has learned to trust us to keep her safe.

It hasn't been easy, and won't be easy, but our connection with her has deepened and grown stronger as we have learned to adapt to this new challenge. I am amazed at how quickly she has learned to respond to our guidance with the slightest pressure on the leash. If only we could be this responsive to God's guidance in our lives.

God uses the Holy Spirit to give us a nudge now and then. God gives us a long leash. As we continue to come through this difficult time of physical separation in our lives, know that God is with us still. Jesus came to this earth for a reason.
