### Love Offering for 2021

Each year, churches in the Minnesota Annual Conference take a Love Offering for missions. The offering is brought to annual conference session—a gathering of United Methodist clergy and laity from across the state.

Donations to the 2020 Love Offering totaled \$51,416, which went to Simpson Housing Service (40 percent), Emma Norton Services (40 percent), Joyce Upton Foodshelf (10 percent), and the Minnesota Conference Committee on Native American Ministry's diaper drive (10 percent).

The theme of the <u>2021 Annual Conference session</u>—taking place virtually June 22-24—is "Jesus. Waymaker." The Love Offering provides the opportunity to experience the joy of doing way-making work with Jesus.

The funds from this year's financial offering will to go four projects:

- The Methodist Border Friendship Commission (50 percent). Funds will help provide supplies, shelter, and transportation for La Posada Provencia's long-term and short-term clients.
- Three host churches of Ruby's Pantry (20 percent). Funds will be shared by Albert Lea UMC, First UMC in Duluth, and Forest Hills UMC and will be used to purchase supplies needed to facilitate the distribution and to pay for shares for families who are unable to pay the \$20 donation to receive an abundance of high-quality grocery items.
- Matthew 25 food distribution (20 percent). Originating at Spirit River Community UMC in Isanti, this food distribution ministry is now a partnership between Spirit River, the Spirit River Foundation, and Coon Rapids UMC. Funds will go towards materials so that Matthew 25 can expand its ministry.
- Volunteers in Mission scholarships (10 percent). Participants serve in all 50 states and more than 100 countries. Funds go to help offset the cost for first-time participants.
