WAR MAKER

"Tell me the name of your wound and I'll tell you the road (\dots) "

Based on Palestinian artist Karim Shaheen's true story, War Maker is a voyage into Karim's dreams and delusions. With the mise-en-scene as a resonance chamber, the audience will start sharing right from the beginning the artist's mindset. Having lived within an ongoing exile, Karim's life is standing at the crossroads where the performance itself mirrors his broken war memories and the liminality of his existence.

On stage the conditioned matter rebels. The vulnerability of the objects can transmit its own memory and traces of time. Let's listen. Scraps, remnants, stains, ruins are object-stages that in its weak existence are capable of framing the totality of the testimonies.

HIS JOURNEY

Contrary to his background, Karim Shaheen, an artist who crafted traditional, folk miniature facades of the ancient city of Damascus, dreamt of nurturing his passion for sci-fi films and becoming a visual effects designer of the silver screen in America.

Since his early childhood, Karim and his family encountered war. First, the Iran-Iraq War (1980-1988); second, the invasion of Kuwait during Gulf War in 1990; and then, Yugoslav civil Wars in 1991.

Deported from Syria in 2000, Karim fled to more congenial countries. His passage through Russia, Ukraine, Romania, and Hungary finally destroyed family bonds.

The human process of reconciliation with the flaws and accidents of time retains the same wise principle as the art of Kintsugi: to respect what is damaged and scarred, vulnerable and imperfect. A so much needed call in an age that worships youth, perfection and newness.
