SPACE

- set up: min. 2 hours
- set down: min. 1 hour
- min. 4x3m playing area, no dance floor needed, white wall in the background of actors is very appreciated.
- we do need darkness.

LIGHT

6x PAR 64 CP62 1000W (or similar) on dimmers

- 3x backlight
- 3x FOH
- 2x profile fixture (Source Four 20-50 or similar)
 - above the front stage
- house light
- more fixtures would be appreciated for spicing up the beginning choreography (Ex. 3x PAR 64 CP62 1000W with floor stands stage left, on dimmers)

SOUND

- we need to play the sound from our PC from the control room
- PA corresponding to the venue
- 3,5mm jack to the system, DI-BOX appreciated
- 2 microphones
- 2 microphone stands

SUBTITLES

- if you need subtitles, we can provide English text for translation.
- sorry, we do not provide equipment and subtitles operator (*we recommend a projector, PC with a presentation software and a person with great space bar pressing skills, who we can provide the footage of the performance and have rehearsal with*)
