EXTERIOR CHANGES:

All exterior changes must be submitted and approved by the association, prior to construction. All requests **MUST** be submitted in writing using the *Architectural Request Form*. Please keep in mind any construction needing a permit with New Hanover Township will require board approval first, a conditional pending letter from HOA granting approval. The HOA may have more restrictions than the applicable zoning ordinances.
