A little historical perspective on the founding of the Friends of the Robesonia Furnace as we celebrate the 30 year Anniversary of the Districts induction into the National Register of Historic Places

Through the money raised through these festivals, the Friends were able to raise enough money to purchase the former Robesonia Furnace property where our museum is now located. Through a state grant, we were able to purchase the former Furnace Firehouse and move it onto our property. Another state grant paid for the electric service to be installed. Over the years, the money raised at festivals and through grants from the Jannsen Foundation, we were able to install sewer and water and finish the interior of the museum. Over the past 25 years, we have been acquiring artifacts and pictures from the former Robesonia Furnace and Robesonia Borough, most of which are now on display at the museum.

Last year, thanks again to grants from the Jannsen Foundation, we were able to erect a 30×60 ft pavilion which we started using for our own events such as craft shows and the Furnace dinner. We have many events planned for this year. The pavilion is available for rent, \$75 for members, \$125 for non members.

Upcoming Events at the Furnace Pavilion

This year the Friends of the Furnace have planned a number of events at the Furnace Pavilion:

- Saturday, March 20th will be the Easter Craft show with Wes Mucky, Barbara Strasser and Lucky's metal working, 10am to 2pm.
- Saturday, April 10th, 4Play will be playing for a Rock the Furnace Event. Tickets are \$5 per person. Food will be for sale.
- Saturday, May 8th Flamin' Dick and the Hot Rods will be playing for the next Rock the Furnace event. Tickets will be \$10 per person. Food will be for sale. Cruisers welcome and will be given special parking.
- Tuesday, May 18th will be the Annual Furnace Dinner starting at 5:30 pm at the pavilion.
- Saturday, June 12th, 39 with Honor will be holding a fund raiser for Wreaths Across America. Multiple bands will be playing and food will be for sale.
- June 19th and July 23rd the Friends of the Furnace will be hosting campfire programs starting at 8pm. Each event will feature a slide show and talk on the Furnace History. Members are free, non members are \$5 each. Marshmallows and hot dogs will be available to roast over the campfire.
- Saturday, August 7th is the town wide yard sale. The Furnace will be renting spaces under the pavilion for \$10 each.
- Saturday, August 23rd is the Summer Craft Show from 10 am to 2pm.
- Saturday, November 20th will be the Thanksgiving craft show, 10 am to 2pm








