We present "Shikshanoday," a transformative project to reconstruct "Ramakrushna Pimputkar Vidyalaya", a 16classroom school building comprising 14 classrooms and 2 teachers' rooms—for a tribal Marathi-medium school in Palghar, Maharashtra, serving Kindergarten through Grade 10 (Pre-primary, Primary, and Secondary). Spanning approximately 9,850 sq. ft., this ₹1.95 crore initiative aims to replace a crumbling, unsafe structure with a modern, safe, and fully equipped learning hub for tribal children



Objectives

Primary Goal:

To reconstruct a 16-classroom (including 2 teachers room) school building, ensuring a safe and adequate learning environment for tribal students from Kindergarten to Grade 10.

Specific Aims:

- To reduce the school dropout rate to ZERO in Tribal communities of Maharashtra by implementing targeted interventions & make sure that every child is educated for minimum 12th grade.
- Provide access to quality education to tribal children
- Bridge the digital divide in tribal communities
- Increased Community Engagement and exposure to the outer world
- Promote the participation of tribal children in extracurricular activities to face the world equally

The Crisis

PIMPUTKAR School is facing an urgent crisis. With only six classrooms that too dilapidated, they are forced to operate in two shifts, a debilitating schedule that is actively driving students away. This year alone, a staggering 54 students—nearly 20% of the 300+ student body—have withdrawn due to the disruption and hardship caused by this unsustainable system. This exodus represents not just lost numbers, but lost potential, lost futures. We are at a critical juncture: without immediate action, we risk further decline and the erosion of the community's educational foundation



The Devastating Impact of Two Shifts

Stunted Development:

The truncated school day leaves no room for essential extracurricular activities, skill-oriented programs, or physical activity-based learning. These crucial elements of a wellrounded education are being sacrificed, depriving our students of opportunities to develop their talents, explore their interests, and lead healthy, active lives.

Financial Strain and Inefficiency:

Operating two shifts incurs significantly higher maintenance costs for the school. This drains valuable resources that could be better invested in educational materials, teacher training, and other essential improvements.

Family Hardship:

The two-shift schedule createssignificant logistical challenges forparents, particularly those with multiplechildren attending the school. Coordinating different pickup anddrop-off times adds considerablestress and inconvenience to alreadybusy family lives.

Impossibility of Essential Facilities:

Crucially, the lack of classroom space also makes it impossible to implement vital facilities like computer lab and science lab.

These essential resources crucial for preparing students for the modern world, simply cannot be accommodated within our current infrastructure.



Solution

This is not simply a classroom building project; it is an investment in the future of our children, our community, and the very fabric of PIMPUTKAR School. These classrooms are the key to unlocking a single-shift schedule, a change that will have a profound and transformative impact. A single shift will free up valuable time and resources, allowing us to:

O1 Restore a Complete Education

Reinstating extracurriculars, skill-building, and physical activity will provide a well-rounded education, attracting new families and increasing enrollment for long-term stability.

O2 Create Essential Learning Spaces

Sufficient classrooms will allow us to establish a computer lab and science lab, providing crucial 21st-century skills and hands-on scientific exploration.

(03) Expand extra curricular opportunities

We can offer extended sports, arts, and other enriching programs, fostering well-rounded development and a passion for learning. This will also enable us to recruit specialized instructors, further enhancing educational quality.

These classrooms will serve as a **Skill Development Hub** for practical **livelihood workshops** and a **Career Guidance Center** to guide tribal students toward higher education and job opportunities beyond Grade 10



Project Description

Key Components:

1. Reconstruction of 16 Rooms

- Total Area: 9,850 sq. ft. (14 classrooms + 2 teachers' rooms).
- Design: Earthquake-resistant (IS 1893-compliant), with proper ventilation and natural lighting.

2. Infrastructure Development:

- Furniture: 560 benches and desks.
- Teachers' Rooms: Equipped with desks, chairs, and storage.
- Blackboards, fans, and windows for a comfortable learning environment.

3. Additional Facilities:

- Computer Lab (25 desktops).
- Science Lab (basic equipment).
- Water Storage and Purifier (tanks and RO systems).
- Administrative Office Setup.
- Electrical Work, WiFi Network, and CCTV Security System.
- Sanitation facilities and a small library space.


