Guidelines

- **ART COMPETITION IS IN-PERSON ONLY AND ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN!**
- Art should be original, and work created around one or more of the thirty articles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. **Visit UN.org to select article(s).**
- Artwork should not have any vulgar language and have no discriminating tones.
- Artwork should not display participants name, schools, or school group
- Artwork should be a minimum size of 8x11 and not to exceed 18x24
- Artwork should not weigh more than 10 lbs. for a person to carry without breaking
- All artworks should be created ready for display and free from tangling and possible misplaced objects of the work
- Performing arts should be a minimum of 3 minutes but not to exceed 5 minutes
- Artwork must be dropped off prior to the competition start time
- **Participants must complete registration, upload a brief video or written explanation explaining your artwork and its connection to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights article(s) that inspired your work, include the submission form with a picture or video of your art work by the due date. Failure to do so will disqualify student.**
