

LEWIS TOPOGRAPHICAL DICTIONARY OF IRELAND 1838

Cumber Upper Parish: was divided from Cumber Lower in 1794. In 1831, eight townlands were further subdivided to form parish of Learmont.

Presbyterians have a meeting house at Claudy.

Claudy: in Upper Cumber Parish: 7½ miles ENE of Derry en route to Belfast. Eight cattle fairs. petty sessions. Constabulary
