

WALKDEN

Frederick Walkden was born in **Middlesex, England** in 1839. He immigrated to Australia with his parents and six brothers and sisters.

He married Mary Brennan in 1863 at Rutherglen and they went to the Chiltern area where Fred was a splitter, providing timber for the mines.

A daughter Margaret was born in 1864 but her mother died 6 days later.

Fred Walkden as leaseholder of the **Aireys Run**, is named in the Winchelsea rate books of 1868. The Aireys Run was on the west side of the creek from **Angahook**.

However, **Thomas Roadknight** paid the rates and he had a lease on several other runs at that time. Fred married Elizabeth Pearse in 1868, the daughter of his next-door neighbour, Martha Pearse. **Elizabeth** was the twin sister of **Sarah Pearse** who had married **Robert McConachy**. Farming and grazing became increasingly difficult after Austin introduced rabbits in 1859. They spread rapidly from nearby Winchelsea. Elizabeth and Fred had three children before leaving the district for **Stratford** in 1873.

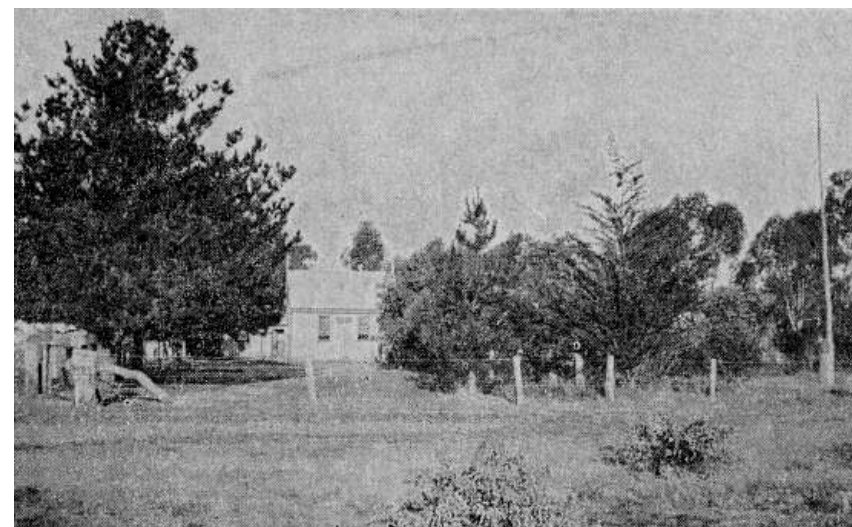
Fred continued grazing pursuits while obtaining his teaching licence, Fred taught at Castle Creek and at Hansonville.

He was head teacher from 1873-1892, of Hanson South, later to become Hansonville school.

Fred and Elizabeth had 14 children and Elizabeth died in 1892 aged just 46.

Fred and some of the children moved to West Melbourne.

The youngest child Amy was brought up by the next-door neighbours, the Baird family.
