Bowie Maryland (February 3, 2024) — The Bowie/Mitchellville Alumni Chapter (BMAC) of Kappa Alpha Psi has pledged to promote and facilitate science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) education and career readiness for pre-college students (6-12) from groups that are underrepresented in these fields. The objectives of the STEM program will be primarily achieved through the launching of the organization's STEM Cybersecurity Academy & the BMAC NSBE Jr. Programs.

On February 3^{rd-9th}, The BMAC STEM Committee (https://bmacstem.org/) hosted a Cybersecurity course and lab: Social Networking and Your Online Identity. This course helped familiarize STEM students with some of the benefits and risks of using social media, and social networking services and provided essential tools to protect their online identity. The program included both a classroom instructional component and a cybersecurity lab where (20) BMAC STEM students earned their Department of Defense (DoD) Cybersecurity Certificates.



With the Omnisource collaboration, we are hoping to provide students in grades (6–12) with supplemental STEM curricula/activities and exposure to STEM concepts.
