We're looking for unique vendors who will help create an immersive Mardi Gras experience for thousands of visitors.

Vendor Commitment

- Vendor space is reserved for the entire event.
- Event Dates: Friday, February 5 – Sunday, February 7, 2027
- Move-In: Friday beginning at 8:00 a.m.
- Operating Hours: Friday 4-8pm | Saturday 10am-8pm | Sunday 10am-4pm
- Load-Out: Begins Sunday at 4:00 p.m.
- Vendors must remain open during all festival operating hours.
- Early breakdown or departure is not permitted.

Vendor Districts

To create an engaging themed experience, vendors will be grouped into specialty districts.

When completing your application, please select the district that best fits your business.

-**Alley of the Arts** (on Historic Granbury Square)

Original artwork, fine art, photography, pottery, sculpture, handcrafted décor, and artisan creations.

-**Makers Way** (on Historic Granbury Square)

Homemade products including candles, soaps, woodworking, leather goods, baked goods, specialty foods, handmade jewelry, textiles, and other handcrafted items.

-**Market Street** (on Historic Granbury Square)

Boutiques, specialty retail, gifts, clothing, accessories, home décor, and unique merchandise.

-**Vino Ville** (on Historic Granbury Square)

Wine, wine accessories, gourmet foods that pair with wine, wine-inspired gifts, and related specialty products.

-**Kids Quarter** (on Historic Granbury Square)

Family-friendly vendors featuring children's activities, toys, educational products, interactive experiences, crafts, and entertainment.

-**Petit Party Parish** (on Historic Langdon Grounds)

Family fun area - seeking "old timey" treat vendors (cotton candy, popcorn, etc.) Yard games, interactive creative space.

-**Food & Beverage Vendors**

Food and beverage vendors are welcome and are encouraged to incorporate the spirit of Mardi Gras into their menu. At least one menu item or offering should reflect the Mardi Gras theme through flavor, presentation, or inspiration.

Applications will be reviewed to ensure a diverse marketplace and balanced vendor mix.

Preference may be given to vendors who:

- Offer original or unique products
- Decorate their booth in a Mardi Gras theme
- Sell products that complement the festival atmosphere
