

## **Trash Fee Update**



## Good evening everyone,

Based on the number of calls and emails I received, most if not all of you received your new trash disposal bill in the mail today. The bill should be for \$45 and represents the first half of the year payment. Invoices for the 2nd half will be sent around September. While this has been pretty widely reported, it has come as a surprise to some of our residents. This was part of the vote of the City Council on Feb.27th that some refer to as the "Bailout". There are many people who are unaware of the particulars of this fee, so I wanted to provide links to both an informational sheet as well as the form that residents over 69 years old can use to file for a \$40 abatement.

I would also like to remind residents that the parking department is enforcing parking violations at all hours of the night. They can ticket vehicles that are not properly registered or parked. The ONLY vehicles that can legally be parked on the streets between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM are vehicles with passenger plates. Vehicles with any other type plate including commercial and livery plates can be issued violations.
