




#### **Out Reach Ministries**

# Guss's Corner

#### DEAR SAC RIVER COWBOY CHURCH FAMILY,

As part of our ongoing effort to support and protect our senior community, we'd like to address an important issue: email and phone call fraud. Scammers often target seniors with deceptive messages, seeking to steal personal information or money. Being aware of these schemes can help keep you safe.

Here are some tips to avoid becoming a victim of fraud:

#### 1. Be cautious with unsolicited requests:

If you receive a phone call, email, or text message from someone claiming to be from a Pastor, Board Member, bank, charity, or government agency, do not provide personal information unless you have verified their identity.

#### 2. Don't rush into decisions:

Scammers often pressure victims to act quickly, claiming something urgent or threatening consequences. Take your time to verify the situation. Personally contact the individual involved or agency by a trusted source or verified phone number.

#### 3. Recognize common red flags:

- Emails or calls asking for gift cards, passwords, Social Security numbers, or financial information.
  - Spelling or grammar mistakes in emails.
  - Requests for payment via gift cards, cryptocurrency, or wire transfers.

#### 4. Verify authenticity:

If unsure, contact the organization directly using a phone number or email address you know to be genuine, not the one provided in the suspicious message.

#### 5. Hang up on suspicious calls:

If a caller asks for personal or financial information, it's okay to hang up. You can always call back a legitimate organization directly to confirm their request.

#### 6. Keep your software updated:

Make sure your phone, computer, and antivirus software are up-to-date to protect against cyber threats.

If you have questions or suspect you've been targeted by fraud, we encourage you to reach out for help. Let us work together as a community to ensure everyone stays informed and protected.
