The Protector's Heart: A Gift, Not a Burden: Some individuals are naturally wired to protect. Whether this is how God created them or how life has shaped them, they possess an innate ability to remain calm under pressure, and discern potential dangers before they arise. For those with a protector's heart, serving is not a burden—it is an extension of who they are.

The Right Calling, The Right People: Over the years, I have seen men and women excel in safety and security ministries. Whether they come from emergency services or simply have a strong gift for situational awareness, these individuals show up, stay alert, and act when it matters.

Serving With Joy: Every ministry—whether it's the worship team, children's ministry, or GUSS ministry—should flow from a joy and a desire to serve Christ.

The Role of Training: Training plays a crucial role in safety and security. Training sharpens and hones the gifts and instincts already present.

Identifying the Right People:

One of the greatest challenges in safety ministries is identifying those who are a natural fit.

The most important traits are:

A Servant's Heart. GUSS ministry is a service to Christ and His people.

Natural Vigilance and Discernment: They possess an ability to act decisively in stressful situations.

Character Over Résumé: Integrity, humility, and reliability matter more than credentials.

GUSS ministry team members receive: Mentorship and coaching,

- 1. First aid training and emergency response preparation.
 - 2. Peace Keepers and church security team training.
- 3. Tactical shooting instruction and ongoing skill development.
 - 4. State and federal law updates relevant to church security.
- 5. US Law Shield protection for legal defense in security-related situations.
 - 6. CCW training (require for all team members).

Serving Where You Are Gifted: The body of Christ is made up of many parts, each with a unique purpose (1 Corinthians 12:7). Just as the worship team requires musical gifts, the GUSS Ministry Team requires vigilance, discernment, and calmness under pressure.
