If you were wondering what this sign is over the stage at the SRCC Event Center, it is how the people of Guatemala tell the story of Jesus.

The first arrow pointing down means Jesus came from heaven to be born in a manger.

The cross signifies Jesus dying on the cross for our sins.

Next to it is the tomb where Jesus was buried.

The arrow pointing up next to the tomb means Jesus rose from the grave and went back to heaven.

The last arrow pointing down means Jesus is coming back someday to take those who have accepted him and believe in him to their heavenly home.

These signs can be found all over Guatemala and are a simple way to share Jesus with others.
