SOMETHING TO THINK ABOOT......by Larry Whiteley GIFTS FROM WISE MEN

The three wise men brought the gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to the stable in Bethlehem. They also brought their hope, their time, and their worship.

The wise men gave Jesus their hope when they saw the light in the night sky. The sight of the star sparked a desire in their hearts. They went, seeking Jesus. 
