SHALL WE GATHER AT THE RIVER

When I was growing up, baptismal services were at a river. Everyone from the church and many friends, family, and other locals would come. The women would bring fried chicken with all the fixings. Watermelon and homemade ice cream were a special treat. Everyone would sing the old gospel song, Shall We Gather At The River.

Sunday, September 10th, we will all gather at the Sac River after our second service at the Livestock Center for our annual Sac River Cowboy Church Baptism at the River.

Before being baptized, you must believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and His death on the cross for our sins. You should confess your sins to God and accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior. That is between you and God. If you want to talk to Scotty, Mark, or any of us, we would love to.

Baptism is a public confession of faith and commitment to Jesus. It is a symbol of His burial and resurrection. Baptism shows that you love, trust, and have put your hope in Christ. Baptism does not save you. Only your faith in Christ does that.

Watching kids to senior citizens stepping into the water for baptism is a blessing. One of my favorite memories was last year when Mark and I baptized a man holding two of his children in his arms. Two years ago, we watched the baptism of a special friend in his wheelchair. Three years ago, my dentist was there playing in one of the bands. He was watching with no intention of being baptized. Then, he walked toward us in the water. It is never too late to make that decision.

I encourage all of you to come and support those taking this step in their Christian life. After the baptismal service, we will go to our Event Center for great food and fellowship, just as they did long ago.



A NOTE FROM SCOTTY

Sac River Folks,

We are experiencing a problem most churches would love to have. We are becoming over crowded.

The most simple solution to the problem is additional worship space - or more seats. The new worship space, soon-to-be-under-construction, will alleviate the problem, but having the new space available may be as much as a year away.

We are building a new worship center north of the Event Center to accommodate over 550 worshippers. Getting from here to there is the problem.

Here is what I am asking you to do. Starting October 1st, let me add **a double second service option**. One second service will be offered at the Stock yards (LMC) at 10:00 AM and a double - second - service will be offered at the Event Center at the same time. Mark Zimmerman will preach a second service at the LMC and I (Scotty) will preach a second service at 10:00 AM at the Event Center (EC). I will preach this double second service as well as our regular first and third service.

Additional changes will occur to accommodate Adult and Children Sunday School classes and fellowship food times.

Why am I asking you to make these changes? So that together we can make a place for those who are coming to find and follow Jesus and want to do it with us. I am willing to add this to my ministry and I am asking you to do the same.

Mark Zimmerman and I will alternate teaching the Thursday night worship service starting in October as well.

Our growth this summer has surprised us because churches don't usually grow in the summer. We are growing and if we have the normal fall growth in attendance, we will not be able to house the crowd.

This additional second service, I believe, will remedy our situation - temporarily.
