The **GOAL** is to promote, preserve and interpret "Our Western Heritage" through the LENS. Western Heritage generally refers to the cultural legacy of the American West, particularly the traditions, values, and history associated with the cowboy way of life, ranching, and the settling of the western frontier.

PHOTOGRAPHY submission RULES (ALL DIVISIONS)

AI is NOT photography.

- An Exhibitor may enter only one Division.
- You are a professional, if you have derived any income, trade, or intent from any service from or about photography in the previous two years.
- No items can be entered in the Owyhee Trails Photofest more than one year.
- Single prints only: Collaged photos are not allowed.
- Photographs Only: All entries must be derived from an original photograph, produced by the entrant, from a camera source.

- Mounting: Photos must be mounted on Foam Core. Item must be firmly adhered to Foam Core. Items must be flush mounted (edge to edge), with no mounting material showing behind the photograph. Mount cannot exceed ¼ inch thick. Unmounted prints will not be accepted. Cardboard, corrugated cardboard, poster board, wood, glass, plastic, metal, etc. are NOT acceptable mounts and will be rejected.
- No frames, glass, mounting hardware, or mats are allowed.
- Prints must be on photographic paper; no metal, acrylic, wood, or glass allowed. Matte or photo paper is acceptable.
- No watermarks, markings, or writing of any kind can appear on the front of the photograph.
- Submissions shall be displayed for the length of the competition and may not be removed until Tuesday following the close of the competition.
- Release Day is Tuesday, September 30, 10 am. to 5 pm.
- Photos not claimed within one week may become museum property.
- Prizes not claimed by Oct 10, 2025 will be considered donations.
- Identification: Each entry must have the following information legibly printed on the back, top left corner: Entrant's name, current address, phone number and e-mail.
