<u>CALL TO ORDER-</u> The Mayor, Robert Mattey, called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm at the Village Hall.

<u>APPROVAL OF BILLS-</u> Village bills were reviewed by Council members. It was moved for approval by Larry Pierce and 2nd by Joe Canter, AIF passed.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES-</u> Tammy Hawk moved to accept the November 8, 2017, meeting minutes. Amy Renner 2nd that motion with a voice vote of AIF.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORT AND REPORT FROM FISCAL OFFICER- The Financial Report was reviewed by Council. There was a Motion to approve the Financial Reports by Larry Pierce and 2nd by Joe Canter, AIF passed.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS-

Ordinance 2017-5 – An Ordinance authorizing the Village to enter into the Southeast Ohio Public Energy Council ("SOPEC") and the execution and delivery of the agreement establishing SOPEC and approving the Bylaws of SOPEC and Declaring an emergency. This matter was tabled to the next meeting as there was not enough Council members present for it to be passed as an emergency reading.

NEW BUSINESS- None at this time.



<u>RESIDENTS COMMENTS-</u> Kari Boyle from the Athens City County Health Department advised that she did receive the bid from York Paving regarding the crosswalk and she is also seeking a bid from McKee Paving. She also advised that the Village will be receiving the grant monies and then the Village will be responsible for paying the contractor for the work.

Eddie Smith thanked everyone for their help in passing the electric aggregation. He also advised that SOPEC is going to be giving back to the Village in form of a monetary contribution. The Mayor asked a couple of questions regarding Ordinance 2017-5 as to Board Members and so on. Joe Canter then introduced the 1st Reading of Ordinance 2017-5 with a 2nd from Tammy Hawk with a voice vote of AIF.

Eddie also advised that there will need to be an Open Public Hearing for questions or comments regarding the aggregation on December 19, 2017, at 9 am and 5 pm at the Village Hall.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT-

The Village Administrator advised that there needs to be a Resolution for the sale of the Village Tractor, Brush Hog, Sickle Bar Mower, and drag blade. Joe Canter introduced Resolution 2017-8 to sell the Tractor, Brush Hog, Sickle Bar Mower, and Drag Blade. This was 2nd by Larry Pierce with a voice vote of AIF.

The Village Administrator advised that he had a meeting with Claypool Electric and they were going to design the electrical upgrade and then take it back to the Commissioners for approval of funds.

MAYOR'S REPORT- The Mayor advised that the next meeting would be a meeting on December 19, 2017, at 5:30 p.m. There was a Motion from Tammy Hawk that the Mayor may sign an agreement with the Athens City County Health Department for the Crosswalk grant monies as a pass through entity. This was 2nd by Joe Canter with a voice vote of AIF.
