ORDINANCE NO. 2013-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2012-16, PASSED December 17, 2012, ORDINANCE NO. 2013-3 PASSED March 5, 2013, and ORDINANCE NO. 2013-9 PASSED September 20, 2013, ENTITLED "APPROPRIATION MEASURES AND REVENUE PROJECTIONS FOR THE VILLAGE FOR THE YEAR 2013 PURSUANT TO R.C. 5705" SO AS TO AMEND EXHIBIT A THERETO, "APPROPRIATIONS," TO ELIMINATE NON-ESSENTIAL REFERENCE TO NON-APPROPRIATED FUNDS; AND DECLARING EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Chauncey, State of Ohio as follows:

Section One: The attached Exhibit A prepared by the Fiscal Officer shall be the appropriation measures for all funds for the Village of Chauncey for the year 2013 effective January 1.

Section Two: The attached Exhibit B prepared by the Fiscal Officer represents estimated income from all sources for the Village of Chauncey for the year 2013 effective January 1.

Section Three: This Appropriation Ordinance may be amended as deemed necessary based on revised tax and budget amounts as provided in R.C. 5705.40.

Section Four: Ordinance No. 2012-16, passed December 17, 2012, Ordinance No. 2013-3 passed March 5, 2013, and Ordinance No. 2013-9 passed September 20, 2013, entitled "Appropriation Measures and Revenue Projections for the Village for the Year 2013 pursuant to R.C. 5705.38" is repealed.

Section Five: This Ordinance being necessary for the fiscal well-being of the Village of Chauncey and necessary to allow continuation of receipts and expenditures without interruption, it is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
