

VILLAGE OF CHAUNCEY
RESOLUTION NO. 2014 - 11

**A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE LAW
ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village has a Law Enforcement Trust Fund designated Fund 2091; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has no police department or Marshal's office; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has no plans in the immediate future to establish a police department or Marshal's office due to a lack of funding and due to the voters of the Village rejecting a police levy; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has an immediate need for the funds in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for other essential Village projects; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Sec. 5705.14 authorizes the transfer of funds from any special fund after termination of the activity, service or other undertaking for which such special fund existed as long as there are no outstanding obligations from such fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Chauncey, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section One: It is hereby determined that there is no purpose to maintain the funds in the amount of \$2815.01 in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund since the Police Department of the Village has been terminated and disbanded and there is no further need for funding for the police.


Section Two: It is hereby determined that there are no plans to establish a Police Department in the foreseeable future for the Village or to establish a Marshal's Office so long as the Athens County Sheriff's Office provides such services to the Village.

Section Three: It is hereby acknowledged by the Village Council that the voters of the Village have at the last two elections voted down the police levy necessary to fund a police department or Marshal's Office.


Section Four: Pursuant to the authority of O.R.C. 5705.14(D), the funds in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Fund 2091 in the amount of \$2815.01 are transferred to the General Fund-Fund 1000, to be used as needed in the normal and routine operations of the Village.

Section Five: There being a shortage of funds in the General Fund for certain necessary projects in the Village before the advent of cold weather, this RESOLUTION is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the protection and welfare of the residents of the Village and shall take effect immediately upon passage.




