# Village of Chauncey Park & Recreation Committee Meeting Meeting Minutes August 4, 2020

CALL TO ORDER - August 4, 2020 at 5:33 via Zoom

#### **ROLL CALL**

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Food Truck Permits, Andrew Chiki
  - Mobile Food Vending Application from the City of Athens is a great start. It has the power of being revoked which is an important provision.
  - The Solicitor also stated that an agreement will need to be established if using private or village property for vending.
  - Suggested a set number of vending applications. Application fee of \$100 and a
    permit fee of \$200. Of course these numbers can be adjusted. The Solicitor asked
    about a percentage of sales fee but Mr. Chiki said the City of Athens doesn't do
    that.
  - o Evelyn stated that we should charge higher permit fees for special events.
  - Possible monthly fees instead of yearly fees since vendors aren't need for a whole year. Mr. Chiki doesn't think that is the best route. You want to lock in vendors for a long period of time which is why annual fees work.
  - The Mayor believes Phase II of the Mine Land Grant involves creating electric service in 1 place at the park. Which will be beneficial for vendors.
  - Mr. Chiki brought up the importance of the "Proof of Insurance" within the application. A \$1M policy is normal.
  - Zero waste is becoming more popular but it doesn't have to be a requirement.
     Will need to establish if it is up to the vendor or the village to provide disposal of trash/recycling.
  - o Sections to address in the Terms & Agreement:
    - Arrival/departure times
    - ADA requirements
    - Item II Suggestions (Reusable products)
  - Solicitor informed the committee a resolution will be needed to adopt vendor agreement.

- Responsible of vendor application: Mr. Chiki said there usually is a point person. They will also review sites after permits have been issued.
- The document will be placed in Google Does for review by the committee/council.
- The solicitor asked about food vendor regulations. All food vendors will have to abide by Health Department regulations which can be found on their website.
- The Mayor brought up the possibility of looking into vendors selling liquor. Will require more research. Possibly during special events.
- Dan Vorisek mentioned that the new VFW owners want to get engaged with the community.

### • Special Event Permits

- o Needs some extra rule writing.
- o Should increase vendor capacity for special events.
- o May need to put something together for the Village and ORCA to agree on.

# Mountain Bike Club, Evelyn Nagy

- OMB Club rally's over the state of Ohio. A lot of cancellation have accorded this year due to COVID-19.
- These events would bring a lot of people and therefore a lot of revenue. Should try to team up with OMB.
- o Committee agreed with responding to OMB saying the application is in progress.

## • Camping, Connaught Cullen

- o Your allowed up to 4 tents before being classified as a campsite.
- o Tent camping space must provide a restroom facility.
- o Bill Hayes mentioned an idea of creating revenue through residential camping but the committee is unsure how. Residential camping my cause problems with the development of Chauncey zoning.
- o Dan Vorisck HIPCAMP Simple primitive campsite helper
- Air BNB possibly gives a guest tax, needs confirmed. Though this will need to be explored after the establishment of zoning regulations.
- o "Onsite Camping" rules need placed in the Chauncey zoning regulations.
- Jim Edwards, RV Sites:
  - The Mayor was contacted by Jim Edwards and is really wanting to get started on RV sites.
  - He is still wanting access across Village property. He was never given the OK of a right-of-way easement. He is aware that all decisions will need to go through council.
  - Jim Edwards does have an alternate route if the Village were to decide on not providing the right-of-way easement.
  - Village Administrator mentioned that he is willing to work with the
     Village and help us in anyway. He has also offered the Village equipment

- use if needed. He wants to attract Bailey's Trail visitors with an easy road access to RV site.
- John Canter would like to see a proposal of how this will increase on our resources such as water, sewer, and road wear-and-tear.
- Trailhead Donations, Mayor
  - O Should provide a way for people to give donations. All donations will go towards the Park & Recreation committee for uses such as park maintenance, event expenses, benches, trash cans, etc.
  - o Would like to install a sign board for notices and possibly ad space.
- Senior Center
  - o Speaker and microphone may be needed for events.
- Mountain Biking for the Youth
  - Evelyn and Mr. Chiki brought up the idea of teaching kids abut mountain biking.
     Set up a learning meet and greet.
  - o The Mayor mentioned the library has considered doing a "bike locker" for kids.
  - Need to think of ideas of how to incorporate young people into biking.
  - Mr. Vorisek Possibly reach out to VFW to see if members would want to be mentors for kids.
  - Connaught Maybe OU and Hocking College will do a credits program for students to receive credits for mentoring kids.
  - Mr. Vorisek believes we should find a way to provide quality mountain bikes to kids. Mr. Chiki believes that kids will have a higher appreciation for quality mountain bikes for kids.
- The Bicycle Club needs volunteers for trails. John suggested the idea of putting this on our website and Facebook page.
