

Meeting called to order at 6:00pm

Roll Call – Joe Jenne Jr, Dylan Skees, Karla Dellinger – Barbie also in attendance.

Reviewed, approved, and signed minutes from April’s meeting.

Sewer rates increased as of the beginning of the year; however, water rates were not increased with it. Karla presented the findings of what others around us were charging along with numbers for increasing 2%, 2.5%, and 3%. (Attached) Committee discussed and answered the following questions...

Barbie – where do we get our water? (A) it is self-supplied

Barbie – what is the increase in money for? (A) Water Plant maintenance and upkeep

Barbie – aren’t we getting a grant to pay for it? (A) we applied but it has not yet been awarded

Barbie – stated that the cost-of-living wage increase that people on SS received was 3% and would like to see it be less than that

Barbie – asked if the water quality reports would be posted online (A) wasn’t sure

Committee looked at the numbers and discussed the higher cost for repairs and maintenance, applying for grant funding, how much the increase might affect the residents, and the percentage that was raised with the sewer. While nobody wants to see our bills go up, we also realized the importance of running and maintaining a safe water plant. It is our recommendation to council that we maintain consistency with the sewer rate increase of 3% over the next 3 years to include the remainder of 2026, 2027, & 2028. If passed, the rates would take effect beginning the month following pag.

Mayor Campbell called and asked us to discuss the decorations for the 250 Fourth of July. We talked about decorating the fence at the park by the basketball court with a huge American flag or doing a “cups” design, lights for Village Hall, and RWB ribbons for around all of the poles along the main road. No final decisions were made.

Stop bar and stop sign have been completed at the end of Mill Street!!

- Still need to address Lexington Avenue where Nye Street intersects as it is a zig zag and not straight across. Discussed making it a 3-way stop. Will talk with Chris to get his opinion and find out if there would be any issues with that.

Discussed whether the tree at the end of Lexington makes it hard to see pulling out on to Converse. No action to be taken.

Motion to adjourn made by Karla. Seconded by Dylan.
