**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PAY RAISE TO \$18.35 AN HOUR  
FOR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR.**

**WHEREAS**, Village Administrator is deserving of a pay increase based on their performance and to keep pace with cost of living.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Chauncey, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section One: Effective on the first pay period after the date of enactment of this Resolution, Village Administrator shall receive an increase in their gross base pay to \$18.35 an hourly basis.


Section Two: The Fiscal Officer is authorized to implement the pay raise set forth herein on the next pay period after date of enactment




