BE IT Resolved by the Council of the Village of Chauncey, State of Ohio, that:


Section One: The Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and Solicitor are authorized to execute the Public Defender Contract for current fiscal year of 2018.

Section Two: The Resolution is necessary for the preservation of constitutional rights of accused persons and will take effect immediately.



Resolution 2018-6

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into at Athens, Ohio this 1st day of July, 2018, by and between Athens County, hereinafter referred to as "County", and the Village of Chauncey, Ohio hereinafter referred to as "Village".

WHEREAS, the parties desire to continue to provide legal representation for indigent persons who are charged with violations of City/Village ordinances, or violations of the Ohio Revised Code occurring within the municipality pursuant to Section 120.14(E) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village/City recognizes its responsibility under the laws of the State of Ohio and of the United States of America to provide legal counsel to indigent persons charged with a violation of a Village/City ordinance for which the penalty or any possible adjudication includes the potential loss of liberty, and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to contract for the provision of indigent legal services from July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018 in order to accommodate the State of Ohio fiscal year; versus the County calendar year budget process

WHEREAS, County has reviewed the experience with City/Village and has agreed to provide representation for the above referenced six month term for $\frac{1}{2}$ the annual rate of \$2,224.16; which equals \$1,112.08 and

WHEREAS, City/Village has reviewed said amount and found it to be reasonable;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the mutual promises and agreements hereinafter set forth, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. City/Village agrees to pay County one half the annual amount of \$2,224.16, which equals \$1,112.08 said amount representing the amount reasonably necessary to provide representation for the above term in two quarterly (2) installments of \$556.04 each, payable on the first day of the quarter.
2. In consideration thereof, County agrees to provide legal counsel and representation from July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018 for those (indigent persons who are charged with violations of City ordinances or violations of the Ohio Revised Code occurring within the municipality and who qualify for the same pursuant to eligibility guidelines; and representation and indigency shall conform with the standards of indigency and other rules and standards established by the Ohio Public Defender Commission and State Public Defender.
3. County further agrees to provide annual reports, if requested, to the City indicating the number and type of cases for which the County has provided representation, and further agrees to provide such other operating information as may be required by the City/Village.
4. Whether payment by the municipal corporation for representation of such indigent persons is by contractual amount or fee schedule, said compensation shall not exceed the fee schedule in effect and adopted by the County Commissioners of the county wherein the municipal corporation is located.

5. This agreement may be renewed or extended for additional six month terms with all clauses being incorporated by references within this agreement except the amount of each quarterly payment may be increased. Proper resolution by the parties and appropriation of funding must be made for any extension and copies must be forwarded to the Ohio Public Defender's Office. In the event that the agreement with the Ohio Public Defender's Office and the county is terminated or amended, the city or village, as appropriate, would be notified and adjustments would be made to this contract as negotiated between the county and the city or village where appropriate. Any adjustment must be in compensation only for the above described extension process to apply, otherwise new contracts will be required.


6. All other terms and conditions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and will be incorporated in any extension resolution or appropriation of funding.

"In addition to indigency determination, all rules, standards and guidelines issued by the Office of the Ohio Public Defender and Ohio Public Defender Commission shall be followed."
