VILLAGE OF CHAUNCEY STATE OF OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 2020-6

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A NECESSITY OF EMERGENCY FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS INTO THE SEWER FUND.

WHEREAS, Council has been informed by the Village Administrator that a portion of the sewer line running beneath Main Street has collapsed causing potential harm among the residents health; and,

WHEREAS, Council has been informed by the Village Administrator that the search for emergency funding for repair of the sewer line in question from government sources is not immediately available; and,

WHEREAS, the damaged sewer line has been temporarily and partially opened but is in imminent danger of farther collapsing at any time causing a public health and environmental emergency; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of emergency repair of the collapsed section is \$88,354.70; and,

WHEREAS, the only funds which has sufficient funds to pay for the emergency repairs is the Sewer Fund which cannot be used until the funds are appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the village of Chauncey, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section One: The Company's estimate of \$88,354.70 (attached hereto) is

accepted as a good faith and reasonable estimate for the emergency repairs of the damaged portion of the sewer line under

State Route 682 also known as State Route 682.

Section Two: The efforts to obtain immediate funding for emergency repairs

from governmental agencies of the state and county has been

unsuccessful necessitating the use of Village funds.

Section Three: The Sewer Account funds shall be used to cover the cost of repair

of the Village sewer line infrastructure. The State Highway funds

shall be utilized to repave the section State Route 682 that was damaged and/or removed by the sewer line collapse.

line collapse.

Section Four:

Upon careful deliberation and the consideration of the pertinent facts regarding the damaged sewer line and the requirements of law, Council approves the appropriation of \$88,354.70 from the Sewer Fund and State Highway Fund. Therefore, Council authorizes the Village Administrator, Mayor, and Fiscal Officer to enter into a contract for the emergency repairs of the Main Street/State Route 682 sewer line as described herein and authorizes the Fiscal Officer to pay for the repairs once they are completed, invoiced and approved for payment by the Village Administrator and Mayor.

Section Five:

Because of the imminent danger posed by raw sewage being blocked from the collapsed sewer line in the damaged portion of the Main Street sewer line and by raw sewage being caused to backup into the homes of Village Residents, and the public health hazard that discharge of raw sewage from overflowing manholes poses to the Village residents, and the environment, this Resolution is declared an emergency enactment necessary to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


