RESOLVED, That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Subdivision at the general election to be held at the usual places within said (Primary, General or Special) subdivision on November 4, 2016; and be it further.

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February Settlement next succeeding the election, if majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further.

RESOLVED, that the Clerk or Fiscal Officer of the said Village of Chauncey,
(City, Village or etc.)

County of Athens, Ohio, notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.


