A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PROPOSED RESURFACING PROJECT OF STATE ROUTES 682 & 13

The following Resolution enacted by the Village of Chauncey, Athens County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the LPA/STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Two-lane resurfacing project using an asphalt overlay treatment on State Route 13 and State Route 682 in the Village of Chauncey. Begin work on State Route 682 at the enter Chauncey Corporation limit and end work at the intersection of State Route 13. Begin Work on State Route 13 at the intersection of State Route 682 and end work at the leave Chauncey corporation limit. Total length of work in the Village of Chauncey is approximately 1.06 miles.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Chauncey, Ohio.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The LPA agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C., Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the Right-of-Way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI - Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said Village is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Chauncey to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.


