CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED PROPERTY TAX REVENUE

The County Auditor of Athens County, Ohio does hereby certify the following:

- 1. On <u>June 30, 2021</u>, the taxing authority of the <u>Village of Chauncey</u> certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted <u>June 17, 2021</u> requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by <u>Five (5.00) mills</u>, to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for <u>Current Expenses</u> purposes pursuant to Revised Code <u>§5705.19 (A)</u>, to be placed on the ballot at the <u>November 2, 2021</u>, <u>General</u> Election. The levy type is a <u>Renewal</u>.
- 2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$29,480.*
- 3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$ 6,874,760.
