Physical or verbal misconduct, bullying, inappropriate conversations, or negative comments regarding students, staff, or The Dance Project NW on social media may result in removal from the program.	_____
Attendance	Regular attendance is important for training and dancer safety. Missed classes are not refunded. Consistent absences may affect dancer progress and class placement.	_____
Make-Up Classes	When a dancer must miss class, one make-up class may be taken within one month. A 24-hour notice must be provided by email so the instructor can be notified.	_____
Dress Code	Proper dance attire is required so instructors can safely observe body movement, form, and technique. I have reviewed the Dress Code and understand my dancer must arrive prepared for each class.	_____
Drop Off/Pick Up	Dancers must be dropped off and picked up on time. The Dance Project NW is not responsible for children outside of their scheduled class time. If a dancer is picked up more than 10 minutes after class ends, a \$20 late pick-up fee may be charged.	_____
Tuition and Fees	Tuition is due on the 1st of each month. Tuition is based on a monthly average and does not fluctuate month-to-month. If tuition and other current invoice charges are not paid in full by the 10th, a \$20 late fee will be added.	_____
Communication	I understand the importance of providing a current email address and checking it regularly for studio communication.	_____
Returned Checks	If a check is returned due to insufficient funds, a \$25 returned-check fee will be added and must be paid within 30 days.	_____

Credit Card Authorization

Required: To ensure timely payment of tuition and fees, each dancer account must have a credit card on file.

If charges due for any given month, including but not limited to tuition, late fees, costume fees, and competition fees, are not paid before the 25th of that month, the card on file will be charged for the full past-due amount. Our system charges a DSP transaction fee for each credit or debit card payment.

Families may choose Auto Pay, which charges the card on file for the account balance on the 3rd of each month. The DSP transaction fee applies to these payments.

If you do not wish to use a credit or debit card, remit payment for your monthly statement in full by the 24th of each month, and your card will not be charged.

Season Fees

- One-Time Season Registration Fee: \$45
- Costume Fee for performing recreational classes: \$70.00 - \$90.00 each, including tax
- Recital Costume Deposit: \$20 due December 7, 2026; remaining balance due February 8, 2027

Please note: The fees listed above are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Payment Policies

Unless explicitly written elsewhere, all tuition and fees are due by the 1st of the month.

If full tuition payment for the month has not been received by the 10th, a \$20 late fee will be added to your dancer account.

If an outstanding balance remains as of the 25th, the card on file will be charged and the charge will include the \$20 late fee.

Class drops must be submitted IN WRITING before the 1st of the month. Otherwise, the full monthly tuition charge applies and must be paid as usual.

Inclement Weather: The Dance Project NW follows the Stanwood-Camano School District closure ruling for each day. If school is canceled, dance classes are also canceled for student, parent, and staff safety. Make-ups and/or refunds will not be provided.

Class	Required Attire
Ballet/Jazz Combo, Creative Ballet, Intro to Ballet, Ballet 1	Pink, purple, or blue leotard; pink ballet tights; optional tutu/skirt in any color; pink ballet shoes with bows tucked in; hair in bun.
Ballet 2, 3, 4, 5 & Barre	Black leotard; pink ballet tights; pink ballet shoes; hair in bun.
Ballet 6	Black leotard; pink ballet tights; optional skirt after barre; pink ballet shoes or pointe shoes; hair in bun.
Jazz/Acro, Jump into Jazz, Disney Jazz, Tumbling Tots	Leotard; optional shorts; bare feet for acro; nude jazz shoes for jazz; hair up out of face.
Jazz/Musical Theater	Leotard or sports top; spandex shorts, leggings, or tights; nude jazz shoes; hair up out of face.
Tap	Leotard or sports top; optional t-shirt/tank; spandex shorts, leggings, or tights; black tap shoes; hair up out of face.
Lyrical/Contemporary	Leotard or sports top; spandex shorts, leggings, skirt, or tights; tan half-sole shoes; hair up out of face.
Hip Hop/Jazz Funk/Conditioning	Leotard or sports top; optional t-shirt/tank; athletic shorts, leggings, or joggers; clean sneakers; hair out of face.
Boys	T-shirt or tank; all-black or all-white for ballet classes; black dance pants or joggers; black genre-appropriate shoes.
Open/Choreography	Any of the above-listed attire; hair out of face; clean sneakers, half soles, and/or jazz shoes as needed.

Shoe Brand Note: The listed shoe brands/styles are examples. Families may purchase these brands or similar options that meet class requirements.

Shoe Type	Recommended Example
Ballet Shoes	Bloch "Performa" Canvas Ballet Shoe or similar
Pointe Shoes	Vary by individual dancer; dancer must be fitted at a dancewear shop
Jazz/Musical Theater Shoes	Bloch "Pulse" Slip-On Jazz Shoes or similar; for extra tiny feet: Dynadans Leather Slip-On Jazz Shoe with elastics or similar
Tap Shoes	Tiny Tappers: Capezio "Mary Jane" Buckle Strap Tap Shoes; All other: Capezio Cadence Oxford or similar
Lyrical/Contemporary Shoes	Capezio "Pirouette II" Leather Lyrical Shoe or similar
Hip Hop Shoes	Any black/white sneakers; must be clean and not used outside of class
