Support essential employees

Buy gift certificates from your favorite local businesses. Save them for later or give them as gifts to your grocery store cashier, mail carrier, or anyone else providing vital services in your community.

Order takeout or delivery on the nights you used to eat out and tip well to your delivery person. Some restaurants are selling off their food stock to help with cash flow; phone your neighborhood spots and buy from them when you can. Supporting local businesses when possible will help these essential employees remain employed.
