Purse Payout: After the race and technical inspections, Bubba Raceway Park will conduct the purse payout.

Pit Parking: We will be coordinating pit parking with the track and USAC officials.

STARS Apparel: We will have fully stocked apparel at the STARS trailer for all of your STARS wearable needs.

Rules: 2019 Bilstein Modified Lite STARS Rules. (Go to www.modlitestars.com)

Pre-Race Inspections: All cars entered must pass pre-race inspection prior to any on-track activity. Pre-race inspection will take place at the Mod Lite STARS trailer.

Entry Pill Draw: All drivers entered must draw for a position in time trial qualifying at the Mod Lite STARS trailer. Pill drawn will close within ten minute at the end of the driver's meeting. If a driver does not draw, that driver will be placed at the end of the qualifying order.

Qualifying/Time Trials:

- 1. Qualifying time trails will take place each day.
- 2. The pill draw will determine which group a car assigned to qualify within. Qualifying will consist of two consecutive timed laps unless otherwise noted. Changes to the two-lap qualifying procedure will be at the discretion of the Mod Lite STARS Series Officials. Any type of 'wave-off' is not permitted.
- 3. Time trials will be closed once all cars that are in line have started their qualifying attempt and have started their time trial. Cars that are late for their designated group will be placed at the tail of the time trial group and given one lap.
- 4. In the event of two or more cars posting the same time in time trials, the tiebreaker will be the qualifying order draw.
- 5. Once any driver has completed their qualifying attempt by taking the checkered flag, that driver must drive to the scale for the minimum weight requirement.
- 6. The heat race lineups will be determined by the results of time trials in a 'heads up' manner.

Non-Qualified Race: Drivers who fail to make all three feature events will be eligible to compete in the non-qualified race scheduled for 15-laps. Lineup will be set by points.

Laps: Feature events will be 20 or 25 laps. Saturday's national race may be moved to 30-laps based on purse amount. The non-qualified race will be 15-laps. Heat races will be 8 laps in length with B-Mains (8-10 laps depending on number of cars).

Track Procedures: All heat races, B-Mains and features will follow normal Bubba Raceway Park track procedures.

Provisional's: Race tracks will choose their provisional first then Modified Lite STARS will select in keeping with the 24-car starting field. The Mod Lite STARS Tour provisional will be chosen from the 2018 points list for the national race scheduled on Saturday, Feb 16.

Inspections: Drivers will be required to pass pre-race inspection conducted at the Mod Lite STARS trailer. Top five of each feature will be required to pass a post-race inspection which will be conducted at the Mod Lite STARS trailer. Air compressor will be available.

Scales: If scales are available, all drivers must cross the track scales after qualifying, heats, B-Mains and Feature events. The race director may modify the number of cars to be scaled.

Scales are Official: Track scales used by the Modified Lite STARS Series are the official scales for that racing event only. The scales might not be calibrated or certified to be considered official.

Raceceiver: Raceceiver communication frequency 454.000 will be used for racing competition only.

Will Hoosier STARS tires be available? Yes, Bubba Raceway Park and Hoosier Tire South will have tires available.

Transponders: AMB/MyLaps Transponders will be required to provide accurate scoring, points, pay, and realignment information during races. Transponders will be available for rent at the USAC trailer.

Race of Champions: The Race of Champions race will be a 20-lap feature taking place on Wednesday, February 13th. Feature line up will be based on hot lap qualifying order with the redraw based on pill draw 0-2-4-6-8 for inversion. Purse pay off will be based on sponsorship and amount of drivers competing.
