Dear Horse Owners,

We are exploring the interest in one-time wellness clinics in 2026. This would be a dedicated service focused on providing essential veterinary care to support the health and well-being of horses in areas of the province that have limited access to veterinary care. These clinics are intended to make routine care accessible, efficient, and centered on prevention.

Kings County Equine offers a range of basic and preventive veterinary services, including dentistry, vaccinations, and comprehensive health exams. These services play a key role in maintaining overall wellness, identifying potential concerns early, and supporting long-term comfort and performance.

To provide high-quality, on-site care, our clinic is equipped with modern portable technology. Available equipment includes portable X-ray and ultrasound units, shockwave therapy equipment, and professional dentistry equipment. This allows us to perform thorough evaluations and treatments in a convenient, low-stress environment for horses.

In order for a wellness clinic to run, a minimum number of participating horses is required. Ideally, horses should be able to trailer to a single location to allow for efficient scheduling and care delivery, or be located within a 5-10km radius of a central location. If you are interested in hosting a wellness clinic at your farm, please reach out to us for additional details and requirements.

Owners interested in seeking care through one of these wellness clinics should verify with their current veterinarian what is required to maintain a valid veterinarian-client-patient relationship (VCPR). These clinics are intended to bridge a gap for horses that do not currently have access to routine veterinary care. If you already have an established working relationship with a veterinarian, a referral from them is required in order to participate in our services.

Owners should also be aware that any horses seen during these wellness clinics will be required to trailer to our home base in Norton for any necessary follow-up care or additional diagnostics. We require that our patients be vaccinated for influenza, rhinopneumonitis, tetanus and rabies at minimum.

Our experienced veterinary team works closely with owners and caretakers to ensure responsible, ethical care and clear communication. Whether your horse is a companion, performance partner, or part of a working program, our goal is to help keep them healthy, comfortable, and thriving.

Thank you for your commitment to responsible horse care. We look forward to supporting you and your horses.
