<u>Background-</u> When the Meyer's Fund was originally given to Grace, the Church Council was assigned the task of deciding how to distribute the gift. A committee was formed to determine, to the best of its abilities, what the best ways were to distribute the funds based on what the Meyer's philosophy, thoughts and interests were.

The committee, as ultimately supported by council, decided that a portion of the funds should go towards ministries and directions related to Christian education, training, and leadership. The desire was to keep the wording very broad and open in order to create as much diversity as possible for groups and individuals to be able to make use of the funds. The target audience would be open to church staff, members, member families, council and leaders. These funds were not meant to be distributed to areas where there were already funds in place to be utilized.
