Readings from 1 John will be Epistle readings in the Easter season in this liturgical (B) cycle. Beginning at 6:30 p.m. on February 24, the second Wednesday in Lent, the Faith Enrichment team will offer a 5-session Zoom class on John's First Epistle. Taught by Jody Marquardt, the series will focus on what we know about the historical setting of the letter and how its emphasis on Christian love as the hallmark of genuine Christianity in action has been important in the Church for 19 centuries. 500 years ago, Martin Luther praised 1

The Social Concerns Team would like to show our appreciation to the staff on the COVID floor of Central Washington Hospital. Emergency Cold Weather Shelter

This winter Grace Lutheran Church is teaming up with the City of Wenatchee, the Women's Resource Center, and First United Methodist Church to provide a low barrier shelter for families and single women that are homeless.

An area hotel has stepped up and is providing six rooms a night for these individuals. Due to the COVID pandemic this year, area churches were not able to provide a shelter as in years past. The Women's Resource Center is reviewing the potential candidates for this program before they are offered shelter. They also will be providing a staff member to be there nightly for security purposes.



The rooms will be cleaned daily and are not used for storage by the clients. Clients have access to the bus for transportation. This program will run for sixty days.


Little Essentials Pantry
