H.R. 299 Blue Water veterans bill has been signed into law. This applies to Vietnam veterans that may have been exposed to agent orange. for info, google HR 299. The message from Department is keep increasing membership. Any veteran that you know that is not a member could be invited to join by you. A new law, LEGION Act S. 504, awaiting President Trump's signature will amend the American Legion charter to allow membership for

any honorably discharged veteran from military service after December 7th 1941 or is presently serving to join the American Legion. This will also apply to the Auxiliary and SAL. Talk this up and bring them in for a visit. As mentioned in last month's newsletter, the membership cards for 2020 are in, so please send in your renewal. The dues will remain at \$30 per year. Early Birds will receive special deals throughout the coming year. The deadline is October 15th, so don't miss out. Life and Honorary Life members are already eligible for Early Bird status. Any member with 50+ years of membership can request that there are dues paid by the Post. Please ensure that a copy of your DD-214 is on file with the Post. We need to be able to verify your service.
