This month, we remember the four chaplains that went down with 670 men on the USAT Dorchester on Feb 3, 1943. Our membership is increasing and we are at 85% of our goal. The dates for membership in the legion were expanded to include all veterans honorably discharged or still serving since December 7th 1941. The remaining requirements remain the same. Any veteran that you know that is not a member could be invited to join by you. Talk this up and bring them in for a visit. Membership renewals have slacked off a little. You still have time to renew for 2020 before your year count rests to one. Any member with 50+ years of membership can request that there are dues paid by the Post. Speaking of dues, they will remain at \$30 for this year. You can renew at www.legion.org or through the mail. Also, we cannot accept any credit card payments. If you tried this, you will need to send in a check or do it online. Reminder, all veterans with honorable or general discharges are eligible to shop online at the various service exchanges.
