This message is one that you need to know. It's about enrolling into the VA healthcare system. Since my hospitalization with COVID last year and although I retired from the US Navy and am supposed to have free healthcare for the rest of my life for my service, well it didn't happen. Tricare (my healthcare insurance), Mass general Brigham and I had a long conversation about my hospitalization billing a couple of weeks ago. Tricare said I did not meet my catastrophic cap and I need to pay my portion of the billing.

After calling several state, congressional and Senator Shaheen office, I made another call to the VA asking for assistance. I found out that I (or a family member) should of called the VA within 72 hours of me going into the hospital and all of my bills would of been paid.

I'm here to tell you, if you have not enrolled into the VA healthcare system you should seriously consider doing it.

There are some stipulations to enroll, you have to have an honorable discharge and your annual income may be a factor? But, you won't know about the income portion until you apply? If you have a general discharge under honorable conditions the VA will assist you getting your discharge upgraded, then you can enroll?
