Matadora

Sport Fishing at its best! This 1987 Southern Cross Sport Fish is a beautiful example of pride in ownership. This vessel has been extremely carefully and meticulously maintained by knowledgeable owners and has been given numerous well-thought-out improvements over their 15 years of ownership.

Southern Cross is a very rare boat with an innovative Tom Fexas hull design incorporating underwater exhausts, hull venting and a narrowed running bottom near the transom. All of this

makes the “Matadora” an unbelievably comfortable and capable offshore fishing machine. Kevlar/fiberglass sandwich construction makes this hull incredibly strong yet lightweight – there are no stress cracks anywhere on this boat! If you’re after a mid-sized sportfisher capable of traveling throughout the Caribbean, “Matadora” is one not to miss.
