

We had a table at the "Rise Up Sisters!" Exhibit as part of the Northwestern Community College's Women's Month of March






EARLY VOTING IN CONNECTICUT IS ARRIVING!

2024 Scholarship Guidelines and Application Process

The League of Women Voters of Litchfield County is a non-partisan organization that provides voter information and encourages citizen participation in government. Membership is open to any person at least 16 years old who subscribes to the purposes and policies of the organization. Student memberships are free.

The league is <u>sponsoring two \$1000 scholarships</u>, with the purpose of encouraging the active participation of youth in the American political process, and in service to their community, both now and in the future.

Award: \$1000 to be used towards the cost of a post secondary education program or career training.

Eligibility: Any senior student, enrolled in a Litchfield County public high school, who has been accepted into a post secondary education or training program

Application Package: The League of Women Voters of Litchfield County Scholarship award applicant package must include the following:


- Proof of acceptance into a post-secondary education or training program
- A written essay (no more than 500 words) making a persuasive appeal to your peers on the importance of voting.
- Evidence of volunteering within the community and/or school, as well as any leadership positions held.
- A Letter of recommendation from a teacher. Letter should be sent directly from the teacher to <u>LWVLCScholarship@gmail.com</u>

The 2024 application deadline is May 1st, 2024

All applications will be reviewed and winners chosen by a committee composed of members of the League of Women Voters of Litchfield County.
